Dear Riverside Band Students and Parents,

It is with great pleasure that we announce that the Riverside High School Band has been chosen to march in a Disney Magic Parade (*we do not yet have the date/time/place for this parade and the number of students that attend could affect our acceptance.*) The Riverside Bands have met the stringent requirements of Disney and passed the application process for a behind-the-scenes Disney workshop and parade with flying colors. This trip is open to any and ALL BAND students in grades 9-12. That's right...9 through 12. This is NOT a marching band trip. This is a band class trip as we have also been chosen to take part in a Disney Backstage concert band workshop in a real recording studio. Students must be enrolled in a campus band class all year.



We have decided to add, for this trip only, the 9th grade band students (Typically the 9th grade band students travel in the spring to Cincinnati.) With Covid-19 affecting the band program the way it has and with all the trips that have been cancelled these past years, we wanted to make sure our Florida excursion happens for everyone! We think the best way to get enough students to make a trip happen AND to keep the cost down for traveling in general, is the combining of forces this year.

The time has come to reserve your spot as a participant in the 2023 Riverside Bands trip to Orlando, Florida! This trip features an exciting array of music education, music performance and fun! The music education highlights include a performance clinic with a world-renowned Disney musician in a real recording studio and a performance in a Disney Parade. Trip participation is on a first-come (first paid deposit and form turned in), first-served basis. There is a limited number of spaces on the buses. Chaperones will be taken the same way.

The tour begins on Wednesday morning, March 22, 2023 and concludes on Tuesday evening, March 28. As with any field trip experience, there are a number of important items that potential participants will need to know prior to tour commitment. This invitation letter is designed to give each student and his/her parents all



the necessary information needed to make a decision for participation. Each student who elects to participate in the trip must return the **Tour Commitment Form** (last page of this packet) and pay the deposit online on the band website –www.riversidebands.com. NO cash or checks will be accepted. Parents must also register their student online with our travel company shortly after committing to the trip. Information will be given to the students when they turn in their Tour Commitment Form.

As the tour draws near, we will have a parent meeting two to four weeks prior to departure to review the tour in greater detail. Who is Eligible?

All students in grades nine (9) through twelve (12) enrolled in the Riverside Campus Band Department and interested parents that may be able to chaperone.

What does the tour look like and include?

For your convenience, we have attached to this invitation letter, our current very *tentative* travel itinerary for March. The parade date is NOT set yet. The workshop date is NOT set yet. Which park we will be in on which days is NOT set yet. This is just a working itinerary until we receive those dates from Disney. Below are a few highlights. While all items listed will be included in this tour, there will be adjustments made to the sequence due to scheduling considerations. Please take a moment to review all the exciting events scheduled for this year's tour.

Highlights:

- Transportation via first-class, DVD-equipped, USB charger equipped, air-conditioned motor coaches
- First-class accommodation for four nights with deluxe breakfasts at the hotel
- Four Disney meal coupons
- Admission to a Disney Waterpark, Magic Kingdom, MGM Studios, Animal Kingdom and Epcot
- Disney Workshop and parade
- Two security guards at hotel in evenings
- Dinner and show at Medieval Times

Who will be supervising the students?

Mr. Schwartz, Mr. Allen, Mr. Wolf and Mr. Wolf will be chaperoning the trip this year. The primary contact for the trip is Mr. Schwartz. We will need chaperones to assist with student management, bus management and general activities. We will take as many parents as we can. If you are interested in going on the trip, please fill out the attached form and pay **separately** on the band website—www.riversidebands.com. Chaperone cost is the same as the student, even though chaperones are in double rooms, not quads. Space is on a first-come, first-served basis.

As a student, what are my responsibilities regarding the tour?

First and foremost, it is important for each participating student to be aware that he/she must abide by all Riverside School District policies regarding behavior and conduct for the entire duration of the tour. The Riverside administration wishes to make clear that any infraction on this tour will not be tolerated. Second, we want to make all students aware that the code of conduct for this trip (which you will receive as the tour draws nearer) is also in effect for the duration of the tour.

ALL students are required to get ANY AND ALL work missed by leaving school three days early. Late work is not acceptable. (*Leaving Wednesday and not Thursday was the ONLY way possible to get buses for the trip.*) ALL students are required to have ALL music for the parade memorized completely before we leave on the tour. No students may go on the trip without **complete** memorization. If you are worried, students can get their music sometime in November. It will be the Salute to America's Finest that we typically play for Memorial Day. Students may do memorization checks with any of the directors. We can help! Do NOT wait!

Tell me about refunds.

Naturally, it is imperative that each family remains committed to this tour. However, unanticipated and rare events can occur which may adversely affect tour participation. We are stating, as concisely as possible, that the **ONLY** way to qualify for a refund is to enroll in our tour company's "**Travel Insurance through TripMate Insurance**" program. We have included information on the two packages available in this packet. The insurance requires enrollment online when you register your student for the trip. (Again, you will receive enrollment instructions as soon as the form AND payment has been received.) Enrollment in the insurance if you so choose, must be made by October 25th, 2022. The Riverside Bands and Bob Rogers Travel, Inc. are HIGHLY recommending that you take advantage of the Enhanced Insurance program. The reason for this recommendation is this: if for some unforeseen reason, ie. Covid spread, Monkeypox, war, etc. and the school decides to cancel the trip, the insurance company will NOT reimburse any money if you have the standard insurance. That falls under a category in the fine print that excludes them from paying. The "Cancel For Any Reason" or "Enhanced" would cover that (up to the percentages listed) to within two days of the trip. The choice, however, remains with you.

What is the total cost and payment schedule?

We are thrilled to provide for each participating family a plan to make this trip more affordable. We have designed this plan to break up the total cost of the trip over a time period.

The total cost of the trip is approximately \$1725.00. The Riverside Band Boosters have already committed funds to every student going on the tour that participates in the band fund raisers. The Band Boosters are giving \$150.00 per student attending. That would lower the cost to \$1575.00. There are several factors that will determine the final cost of the trip. (The cost should not rise above \$1725.00. The cost has never risen in all the trips WE have taken.) The first and biggest factor in the cost of the trip is the number of people attending. If more people attend than my initial estimate, the cost of the trip will decrease. The opposite is also true. If fewer people attend than my initial estimate, the cost of the trip could rise. The other major factor is your student's participation in the fundraisers.

There will be a separate fundraiser for the tour participants (after other booster sales) that will directly impact the cost of their individual trips. For this fundraiser only, all profits the individual student makes, comes off their individual trip cost. We have had many students pay for all or most of their trip this way. It's work, but isn't that how we make money?!?!?

Staying Behind...

The question always arises..."Can we keep our student down in Florida at the conclusion of the trip?" The answer to that is a resounding "Yes"! Arrangements will be made to meet up on the last day of the tour to make the tradeoff for your student, luggage and belongings.

- **PLEASE** pay in the correct designation (Deposit, 2nd Payment, 3rd, Etc.) and the correct amount.
- Make sure to put student name in the NOTE section, especially if your last names are different.

Please be aware that the payment designations and system say “Donation” and “Gift.” It is NOT a donation or gift—it is your payment. We use this site because it is cheaper to use than a site such as PayPal or Blue Sombra. Know that we do NOT have access to any financial information.

Our online payment system just changed its operating platform. Nothing, however, except the look of the site will change for you if you have used the booster payment site before. All accounts, logins, information, etc. will automatically become part of the new system.

The least expensive way to the band boosters for you to pay is by using a checking account when you sign up for OUR online payment system. Ultimately, this savings will be passed on to you if the boosters’ online fees are much lower than expected. It would come off the last payment.

This will be a unique experience for our band family. We hope that you will be able to take advantage of this great opportunity. We will help your students in any way we can to participate in this awesome trip. Yes.
