

"I will put enmity between thee (Satan) and the woman, and between thy seed (the Wicked) and her seed (**The Messiah**); it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel." Genesia 3:15

"The Lord thy God will raise up a Prophet (Messiah) from among their brethren, like unto me (Moses); unto him ye shall hearken." Deuteronomy 18:15

"I will raise them up a Prophet (Messiah) from among their brethren, like unto thee (Moses), and will put my words in his mouth; and he shall speak unto them all that I command him. And it shall come to pass, that whosoever will not hearken unto my words which he shall speak in my name, I will require it of him." Deuteronomy 18:18.19

"Joseph is a fruitful bough, even a fruitful bough by a well; whose branches run over the wall: The archers have sorely grieved him, and shot at him, and hated him: But his bow abode in strength, and the arms of his hands were made strong by the mighty God of Jacob; (from thence is the Shepherd, the Stone of Israel (Messiah):" Spoken by Jacob. *Genesia* 49:22.24

"The scepter (a King) shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh (Messiah) come; and unto him shall the gathering of the people be." *Genesia* 49:10

"There shall come a Star out of Jacob, and a Sceptre (Messiah) shall rise out of Israel." Numbers 24:17

"Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son (Messiah), and shall call his name Immanuel (God with us)." "Poaiah 7:14" (The Child must be conceived by the Spirit of God, for her to remain a virgin. God being his Father meant he would be born without original sin, holy blood for the Atonement.)

"But thou Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me (Be Born) that is to be ruler in Israel; whose going forth have been from of old, from everlasting." Wieah 5:2 (God the Son, your Messiah)

"For unto us is born (in a stable the Lamb of God), unto us a son is given (Messiah, to make the Atonement): and the government shall be upon his shoulder and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counseller, The mighty God, The Everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace." Peacal 9:6 (His First Coming, as your Passover Lamb Saviour, sacrificed for your sin.) "Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will perform this." Peacal 9:7 (At His Second Coming, in the clouds of heaven with his Saints, to reign.)

"The voice of him that crieth in the wilderness

(spoken by John the Baptist), Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make straight in the desert a highway for our God (Messiah). And the glory of the Lord shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together." Psaiah 40:3,5

"Behold my servant (Messiah), whom I uphold; mine elect, in whom my soul delighteth; I have put my spirit upon him: he shall bring forth judgment to the Gentiles." Isaiah 42:1

"Kiss the Son (Messiah), lest he be angry, and ye perish from the way, when his wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all they that put their trust in him." Pealm 2:12

"In the tenth day of this month they shall take to them every man **a lamb**, according to the house of their fathers, a lamb for an house:" "Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male (**Messiah without sin**)." "Israel shall kill it." "When I see the blood, I will pass over you." Exodus 12:3.5.6.13

"And they shall take of the blood (of the Lamb), and strike it on the two side posts and on the upper door post of the houses (Messiah, pardoning sin by his blood on the cross)." Exodus 12:7

"Abraham said, My son (Isaac), God will provide himself a lamb (himself, God the Messiah)." Genesia 22:8

"And Moses made a serpent of brass, and put it upon

a pole (Cross), and it came to pass, that if a serpent had bitten any man, when he beheld the serpent of brass, he lived." (Even so, was the **Messiah** lifted up on a cross, that whosoever looks to him should not perish, but have everlasting life.) *Numbers 21:9*

"I gave my back to the smiters (He was scourged with a Cat-o-nine-tails. A whip with nine knotted cords with pieces of metal tied in the ends, to dig in and rip his flesh to shreds.), and my cheeks to them that plucked off the hair (They ripped his beard out by the roots. He was bloody raw flesh, from head to foot.): I hid not my face from shame and spitting." Psaiah 50:6

"For dogs have compassed me: the assembly of the wicked have inclosed me: they pierced my hands and my feet. (**Messiah** crucified) I may tell all my bones: they look and stare upon me (He was crucified naked). They part my garments among them, and cast lots upon my vesture." *Psalm 22:16-18*

"I became also a reproach unto them: when they looked upon me they shaked their heads." (While he hung upon the cross.) Pealm 109:25

"Behold, my servant (Messiah) shall deal prudently, he shall be exalted and extolled, and be very high. As many were astonied at thee; his visage was so marred more than the sons of men." (They scourged and crucified the Messiah, the Son of God, the Passover lamb.) So shall he sprinkle many nations (With his own blood, making the Atonement); the

kings shall shut their mouths at him: for that which had not been told them shall they see; and that which they had not heard shall they consider." Jeaich 52:13-15

"Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the lord revealed? For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of dry ground: (The Son of God, born of a virgin, supposed the son of Joseph. A carpenter of the house of David. Born in Bethlehem, raised in Nazareth.) he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him. He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not. Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted (For our sins). But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the Lord hath laid on him the iniquity of us all. He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a (Passover) lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth. He was taken from prison and from judgment (He was pronounced innocent by Pilate the Governor): and who shall declare his generation? for he was cut off out of the land of the living (Killed): for the

transgression of my people was he stricken. And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death (Israel's Rock, buried in a rich man's grave, which was hewn out of Rock.); because he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth. Yet it pleased the Lord to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed (When He Rose from the Dead), he shall prolong his days (He was seen by many of his Disciples for forty days. As many as five hundred at one time.), and the pleasure of the Lord shall prosper in his hand. ("Who being the brightness of his (God's) glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high." Hebrews 1:3) He shall see of the travail of his soul, and shall be satisfied: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities. Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out his soul unto death: and he was numbered with the transgressors (Crucified between two thieves.); and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors (On the cross he prayed: "Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do." Luke 23:34)." Isaiah 53:1-12

"For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell (the grave); neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see

corruption (The Messiah must be raised from the dead.)." Pealm 16:10

"Thou art my Son; this day have I begotten thee (The Son rose from the grave)." Psalm 2:7

"The Lord said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool (God said to my God)." Pealm 110:1

"Behold, I lay in Zion for a foundation a stone, a **tried stone**, a precious corner stone (**Messiah**), a sure foundation: he that believeth shall not make haste." *Psaiah* 28:16

"The stone (Messiah) which the builders (Israel) refused is become the head stone of the corner." Pealm 118:22

"For who is God save the Lord? or who is a rock save our God (Messiah)?" Psalm 18:31

"The house of Israel went into captivity for their iniquity: because they trespassed against me (Messiah), therefore hid I my face from them, and gave them into the hand of their enemies: So fell they all by the sword. According to their uncleanness and according to their transgressions have I done unto them, and hid my face from them. Therefore thus saith the Lord God; Now will I bring again the captivity of Jacob, and have mercy upon the whole house of Israel, and I will be jealous for my holy name; After they have borne their shame, and their

trespasses whereby they have trespassed against me." Ezekiel 39:23-26 (The Jew's Priests and elders had called a secret meeting in the night, and like a pack of ravening wolves condemned their Messiah to death. They then delivered him to the Roman Governor Pilate, to Kill. Pilate said: "I, having examined him before you, have found no fault in this man touching those things whereof ye accuse him." Luke 23:14 But the Jews cried out: "Away with this man, and release unto us Barabbas (a murderer)." Luke 23:18 "Pilate therefore, willing to release Jesus, spake again to them. But they cried, saying, Crucify him, crucify him." Luke 23:20,21 "And Pilate gave sentence that it should be as they required." Luke 23:24 They nailed him to the cross and set a sign over his head reading: "This is Jesus The King of the Jews." Matthew 27:37 He was Crucified on Wednesday morning at nine, and hung on the cross for seven hours and Died. He was buried in a new tomb hewn out of rock, with a huge stone over the opening and sealed and guarded by Roman soldiers. Three days and three nights, Dead. At sunrise Sunday morning He Rose from the Dead, He is Alive !!

"My God will cast them away, because they did not hearken unto him: and they shall be wanderers among the nations." Hosea 9:17
