WDA and West Region: There is a difference

One of the misunderstandings is the Western Dakota Association (WDA) and West Region are one in the same.

Well, yes and no.

The WDA is the conference which includes 11 full members and two associate members. The WDA awards championships in a number of team sports, based on finish in the regular season standings, or at a designated event, such as the WDA swimming-diving championships. The West Region is the name of the postseason tournament administered by the NDHSAA in such sports basketball, volleyball, wrestling and hockey. Although these tournaments feature WDA participants, it is not a conference event, but rather, sponsored by the NDHSAA. The winners are classified as a NDHSAA region champion.

Some team sports don't compile standings, for example, track and field. In this instance, the winner of the West Region Meet is deemed both a region and WDA champion.

The Western Dakota Association (WDA) has the distinction of being North Dakota's oldest Class A high school athletic conference – and its most successful. Now in its 82nd year, the conference has produced over 400 state team championships and numerous individual titles sponsored through the North Dakota High School Activities Association (NDHSAA).

The WDA was established in 1938 by five schools – Bismarck (Central) High, Dickinson (Central), Mandan, Minot and Williston. Since then, the WDA has expanded its membership and the number of sponsored sports/activities. Today, the five charter schools along with St. Mary's of Bismarck, Jamestown, Bismarck Century, Turtle Mountain Community High School of Belcourt and Bismarck Legacy give the conference 10 members. Legacy will begin sponsoring some activities this sports season, and more will be introduced once the school opens in 2015. Minot (Bishop) Ryan, Bottineau-Rugby and Hazen-Beulah are presently associate members, participating in one or more activities.

The conference sponsors team championships in boys and girls sports administered by the NDHSAA. Football was the first sport the WDA awarded a regular season champion. Today, there are 22 sports conducted over three sports seasons. The fall season includes: football, volleyball, cross country (Boys/Girls), soccer (B), swimming and diving (G), tennis (B) and golf (G). The winter season: basketball (B/G), wrestling, hockey (B/G), gymnastics and swimming and diving (B). The spring season: track (B/G), baseball, softball, golf (B), tennis (G), soccer (G). In addition to annual team and individual conference awards, the WDA recognizes outstanding academic achievement through team and individual scholar athlete awards and scholarship. The conference celebrated its 75th anniversary in 2013-14.

Formation and expansion

In the late 1930s, North Dakota's largest high schools, determined by enrollment, were part of an East-West Class A Conference recognized by the High School League (later to be renamed the NDHSAA). To keep travel costs to a minimum, and mainly out of convenience, schools would schedule football games against schools in their immediate area.

Unfortunately, schools based in far western N.D. had a more difficult time filling their schedules since they had fewer programs of comparable size around them. These schools often would resort to playing teams from neighboring Montana. To remedy this problem and create continuity in football scheduling, five schools – Bismarck (Central) High, Dickinson (Central), Mandan, Minot and Williston – agreed to form a western division within the Class A East-West Conference. And with that, the Western Dakota Association was created in 1938.

The look of the conference has changed over its seven-plus decades of existence. It expanded from its original five schools to eight in 1944 when St. Mary's of Bismarck, St. Leo's of Minot (later to be known as Bishop Ryan) and Jamestown joined. St. Leo's initial stay was brief, however.

After one season it left the conference to compete against smaller schools in its region. St. Leo's returned for two football seasons in 1952-53. In 1954, Rugby was admitted and participated in the football conference.

A significant change happened in the spring of 1960. Class A schools agreed to disolve the current East-West Division format used in such sports as football and basketball. At a meeting in Jamestown in April, representatives from 10 schools agreed to expand the WDA's oversight in other sports and activities. The 10 schools were: Bismarck, Bismarck St. Mary's, Dickinson, Jamestown, Mandan, Minot, Williston along with Minot Bishop Ryan, Harvey and Rugby. As part of the association, schools agreed to play a round robin schedule of games, beginning in 1961. Rugby, Harvey and Minot Bishop Ryan, however, opted not to field a team for football, so the number of WDA football participants was seven. And speaking of football, the most significant change to come out of the decision to do away with the Class A East-West Divisions was the discontinuation of the end-of-season title football game between the winner of the East Division and WDA (West Division). That decision was not unanimous. A majority of coaches and school officials in western N.D. wanted the game to continue to assure an annual champion in the sport. Opponents, schools in the East, pointed to weather and distance of travel as factors in opposing the late-season contest.

Jamestown departed the WDA in 1963 and competed as a Class A independent before becoming a charter member of the Eastern Dakota Conference in 1968. Minot Bishop Ryan rejoined the conference as full members in 1964. Rugby and Harvey left the conference in the mid-1960s. Dickinson Trinity was added in 1969 as a football member and eventually became a full member.

Membership remained at eight until Bismarck Century opened in 1975. With the exception of its tennis program, Minot Ryan would leave the conference in 1977 and participate as a Class A independent before joining the North Star Conference in 1980.

Four associate members – Bottineau, Devils Lake, Jamestown and Park River – were added to the conference in boys hockey, beginning in 1980 when the NDHSAA established a West and East region for the sport. Park River would leave after just two seasons and eventually co-op with neighboring Grafton. Bottineau, Harvey and Turtle Mountain Community High School (Belcourt) would compete as associate members in girls volleyball, beginning in 1982. Also that year, Minot Bishop Ryan's gymnastics program competed in the WDA.

TMCHS would join as a full member in the fall of 1990 after the Class A North Star Conference disbanded following the spring of that year. Its football program would play in the conference from 1993-96.

In 1990, Minot Ryan would return to the WDA except for football, which would re-

main independent. Minot Ryan and Dickinson Trinity left following the 1991 sports season to compete in Class B in all sports except tennis, which would remain part of the WDA.

In 1992, Hazen-Beulah was added as an associate member in hockey. Center would participate in boys swimming and diving as an associate member, starting with the 1993-94 season. Jamestown's soccer programs competed as an associate member, beginning in 1995. The Blue Jays hockey program moved to the EDC/East Region in 1996. The school was already competing in the EDC/East Region for most activities. Dickinson Trinity would no longer participate as a full member in tennis after 1996. Instead, the school would co-op with Dickinson.

In 1997, Jamestown would return to the WDA as a football member as part of the restructuring of the sport by the NDHSAA into four classes. Center would leave the conference in 1999 as an associate member in boys swimming/diving. Beulah joined the WDA in a few fall sports in 1998 and then joined as full members 1999. Rising student enrollment forced the school to move up from Class B. Beulah would return to Class B competition in the fall of 2006.

In 2006, under a directive by the NDHSAA, Jamestown was realigned in the West Region for all activities, and thus rejoined the WDA. Devils Lake-Cando, an associate member in boys hockey, would move to the EDC/East Region, starting in 2006. Jamestown's football program would return to the EDC for one season in 2009 to create balance among the two AAA football leagues. The Blue Jays would return to the WDA in 2010 after Fargo Davies opened and began play in the EDC.

Minot Bishop Ryan would play its final seasons as an independent tennis program in 2009-10. The Lions would eventually enter a co-op with Minot. Bishop Ryan would join the WDA as an associate member in girls softball in 2009. The Lions would move to Class B softball in 2018. Conference membership has remained at nine for the past several years, but expansion is on the horizon.

Bismarck Legacy joined the conference in 2014 and quickly enjoyed success in number of sports. In the fall of 2018, Watford City joined as a full WDA member. The Wolves previously competed in Class B and have a storied football program. Rising population in Western N.D. has meant increased student enrollment in many places, including Watford City.

COVID-19 forces some 2020 sports and activities suspended, canceled

In the late winter of 2020, the COVID-19 pandemic reached the United States. In response to the rising threat of infection, a national emergency declaration was called. Schools and several businesses were forced to shutdown to slow the spread of the virus. As a result, the remaining winter sports postseason tournaments, including the remainder of the Class A basketball tournament was suspended and eventually canceled. The NDHSAA also suspended and canceled the remaining fine arts competitions for winter and early spring. And finally, in May, NDHSAA officials canceled the spring sports season.

Sports offerings increase

Membership in the WDA is not the only thing that has expanded in 75 years. The evolution of high school athletics/activities has changed the dynamics of the conference as well.

Football and boys basketball were the two competitive sports sponsored in the formative years of high school athletics in the state, but wrestling, track and field, tennis, cross country, golf and hockey would come along. Many schools had established girls sports on a recreational or intramural level by the 1960s, but girls sports would make significant advancement in the decade with the inclusion of track and field, golf, tennis and gymnastics as NDHSAA-sponsored activities.

The 1970s brought additional sports under NDHSAA control, including boys and girls swimming and diving, girls basketball and girls cross country. Beginning in 1982, Class A volleyball would officially be sponsored at the regional level, and a year later, at the state tournament level.

Several schools across the state began boys soccer programs in the late 1980s. The NDHSAA would eventually sponsor the sport in 1995. Girls soccer would also be offered. Baseball, which already was an established Class B sport, would get NDHSAA sponsorship at the Class A level by 2000.

The start of a new millennium brought continued advancement in girls sports. Hockey was added in 2002 and softball began play in the spring of 2010. Today, there are 22 sports featured – an equal split between boys and girls. WDA athletes have moved on to compete at the highest levels of collegiate athletics in their respective sports and several have even reached the professional level, further demonstrating the conference's excellence. Several coaches have also achieved significant milestones as well.

More changes

Over the years changes have also come in the form of new rules, regulations and standards of play directed by the National High School Federation and NDHSAA. Technological advancements and improvements in equipment have enhanced competition and player safety. Other important changes have included greater emphasis on the safety of participants and proper training methods. Coaching development programs have been established and attention given to promoting the practice of good sportsmanship by athletes, coaches and spectators.

Throughout its rich history, the WDA has demonstrated success in high school extracurricular activities can be built on a foundation of character, values and academics.

August

17—Williston made history when it competed in its first-ever NDHSAA-sanctioned varsity boys' soccer match. The Coyotes fell 9-2 to G.F. Red River in a game played in Jamestown. Jovany Charles scored both Williston goals.

30—Bismarck St. Mary's dedicated its new home field, Our Lady of Victory Stadium/Dan Smeekar Field. The facility is on the campus of the new St. Mary's Central High School. Over 2,000 attended the dedication and first game vs. rival Fargo Shanley. The Deacons won 33-21.

September

23—Century, the WDA regular season champion, won the West Region girls' golf tournament hosted by Williston with a 334 team score. The Patriots along with Minot, Williston, Jamestown, Bismarck High and St. Mary's qualified for the state team tournament. Hannah Herbel of Century is tournament medalist with a 78. She defeated sister, Leah, in a playoff for medalist honors.

October

1—Century won its sixth Class A girls' golf team title. The Patriots finished the two-day tournament hosted by Wahpeton-Breckenridge, MN with a 661 team score. Williston was runner-up. Century's Hannah Herbel was state medalist. This was her second consecutive title.

3—Legacy, the WDA regular season boys' tennis champion, won its fifth-straight West Region Tournament title. The Sabers bested Minot, 4-1, in the dual championship held in Bismarck. Those teams along with Century and Jamestown also qualified for the state dual team tournament.

5—WDA regular season boys' soccer champion Bismarck High edged rival Century, 2-1, to win the WDA Tournament title held in Bismarck. BHS, Century along with Minot and Mandan all qualified for the ND State Tournament.

10—Legacy was the top WDA finisher at the ND state boys' team tennis tournament held in Grand Forks. The Sabers were fifth. Fargo South won the championship.

14—WDA football teams resorted to playing games on Monday due to a snow storm the previous week that wiped out games scheduled for the traditional Friday night time slot.

15—Williston defended its WDA boys' cross country championship while Minot won its first conference girls' CC title since 2007. Dickinson's Brady Yoder was the individual boys' champ (15:40/5K) while Jamestown's Meghan Ford defended her girls' title (17:49/5K). Dickinson hosted the meet. The event was planned for Jamestown, but moved due to wet course conditions as a result of a snow storm.

16—Bismarck High won its fifth boys' soccer state title, and third in the past five seasons. The Demons bested Fargo Davies, 3-0, in the tournament championship held in Mandan. The squad finished 15-1-3 and its only loss came to Moorhead, MN. Century finished fifth at the tournament which was held Monday-Wednesday due to a snow storm the previous week.

26—Century captured the Class A boys' cross country title. It was the Pa-

triot's third crown. The WDA took the top six spots (Century, Williston, Dickinson, Jamestown, Bismarck High, Legacy). Dickinson's Brady Yoder was individual champion (15:20/5K). Minot was the top WDA girls' team finisher at the state meet, placing fourth. West Fargo won the team title. Jamestown's Meghan Ford successfully defended her individual crown (17:40/5K). The meet was hosted by Minot.

November

9—Century defended its WDA girls' swimming-diving title, scoring 568 points. The meet was held in Bismarck.

15—Century completed the program's first perfect football season. The Patriots defeated West Fargo Sheyenne, 10-0, at the AAA Dakota Bowl held in Fargo. Century finished the season with a 12-0 mark. It was the school's third championship. Bismarck High, Mandan and Minot were also AAA playoff qualifiers. In AA, St. Mary's and TMCHS were playoff qualifiers.

16—Century won its fifth consecutive ND State girls' swim-dive title. The team scored 355.5 points to edge runner-up WF Sheyenne. The meet was held in West Fargo. WDA state individual champions: Lexi Duchschere, Century, 50 and 100 freestyle; Marisa Branham, Williston, 200 IM and 100 breaststroke.

16—Century, the WDA regular season volleyball champion, defeated Jamestown, 3-1, to win its sixth consecutive West Region Volleyball Tournament title. Century and Jamestown were joined by Bismarck High and Mandan as Class A Tournament qualifiers. The region tournament was hosted by Jamestown.

23—Century's bid for a fifth-straight Class A volleyball tournament title fell just short. The Patriots lost to Fargo Davies, 3-1, in the title match held in Fargo. The squad reached the championship match for a ninth season in a row. The loss snapped a 14-match unbeaten streak at the tournament. Jamestown placed fifth while Mandan was seventh.

December

14—St. Mary's formally dedicated its new gymnasium and Tony Wald Court prior to its first home basketball doubleheader vs. Watford City. The Saints won both games.

January

20—For a second year in a row, Jamestown hosted the ND Hockey Day event. The event featured several outdoor hockey games played on the campus of the Univ. of Jamestown. In girls' play, Jamestown faced Devils Lake. In boys' play, Bismarck High played Fargo South-Shanley and Jamestown took on WF Sheyenne.

February

15—Bismarck High, the WDA regular season wrestling champion, won the West Region Tournament held in Watford City.

21—Bismarck High won its 16th Class A state dual wrestling championship. For a fourth year in a row, all four WDA entries in the dual tournament advanced to the semifinal round. (Bismarck, 1st; Minot, 2nd; Jamestown, 3rd; Century, 4th).

21—Dickinson won the WDA gymnas-

tics championship held in Jamestown. It was the Middlets' second straight conference title. Dickinson's Ayana Fossom was the conference all-around champion with a score of 37.825. The meet was hosted by Jamestown.

22—Bismarck High won its 38th Class A wrestling tournament championship. Minot was runner-up; Century, third; Jamestown, fourth. Seventeen WDA wrestlers reached the finals of their respective weight class. WDA individual champions: 106: LJ Araujo, Bismarck High; 113: Christian Tanefeu, Bismarck High; 120: Wilfried Tanefeu, Bismarck High; 126: Reece Barnhardt, St. Mary's; 138: Clay Radenz, Century; 145: Troy Berg, Dickinson; 152: Noah Braun, Jamestown; 170: Gage Roaldson, Bismarck High; 182: Isaiah Huus, Bismarck High; 195: Jacob Carmichael, Minot.

22—Century won the West Region boys' hockey tournament title for a third consecutive season. The Patriots defeated rival and WDA regular season champion Bismarck High, 5-2. Century, BHS along with Minot and Jamestown qualified for the ND State Tournament. The region tournament was held in Bismarck.

29—Dickinson won the ND state gymnastics team title for a fifth consecutive season and 14th overall.

Jamestown was runner-up. Dickinson's Ayana Fossom was the all-around champion with a score of 37.500. WDA gymnasts finished in the top 10 positions in all-around scoring. WDA individual event champions: Ayana Fossom, Dickinson, vault, floor exercise; Haley Nelson, Jamestown, uneven bars; Rachel Schiele, Jamestown, balance beam. The meet was hosted by Dickinson.

29—Bismarck won its sixth consecutive ND state girls' hockey championship and ninth overall. The Blizzard defeated Fargo Davies, 2-0, in the title game played in Fargo. In addition to Bismarck, Minot and Mandan participated in the tournament representing the WDA. Minot's third place showing matched its best-ever finish and first since 2006.

29—Jamestown's fifth place finish at the ND state boys' hockey tournament was the best showing of the four WDA entries. It was the first time since 1992 the Blue Jays won a pair of games at the tournament. G.F. Red River was the champion. For the first time since 2011, a WDA failed to advance to the semifinals.

29—Minot defended its WDA boys' swimming-diving title, scoring 615 points. The meet was held in Bismarck.

March

7—Bismarck High won the West Region boys' basketball tournament, edging WDA regular season champion and top seed Jamestown, 84-79 (OT) in the title game. The Blue Jays were playing their third overtime game in a row. In addition to those teams, Mandan and Dickinson also qualified for the Class A Tournament.

7—Legacy won its first-ever West Region girls' basketball tournament title. The Sabers defeated Century 69-63 in the championship. It was Legacy's third win over the Patriots during the season. Both teams shared the WDA regular season championships. In addition to those teams, Mandan and St.

Mary's also qualified for the Class A Tournament.

7—Minot won the ND state boys' swim-dive championship. It was the Magicians third straight title and 28th overall. Minot scored 463 points. WDA individual champions: Kolden Kringsen, Williston, 200 IM; Chris Birnbaum, Century, 200 freestyle; 500 freestyle; Dominic Yoder, Minot, :52.18; Javier Agüero-Montero, Mandan, :53.29

12—Bismarck High and Jamestown picked up quarterfinal victories at the Class A boys' basketball tournament in Fargo. Mandan and Dickinson dropped its quarterfinal contests. On the girls' side of the bracket, Mandan earned a quarterfinal win. Legacy, Century and St. Mary's fell in its games.

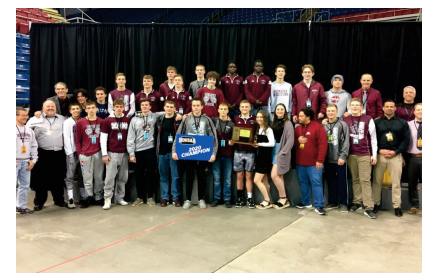
