<p>April 18th 6:30</p>	<p>Maundy Thursday Service and Agape Feast The beginning of the longest part of the trip ... nonstop until Easter.</p>	<p>Stopping by the roadside for a feast with a fabulous service recreating the Last Supper with foot or hand washing. Must stop here for your Lenten Journey. This is the beginning of the service for Easter. Make sure your tank is full, there is no stopping until Saturday.</p>	
<p>April 18th after the Maundy Thursday Service until noon the next day</p>	<p>The Watch a time when we take an hour or more to be present in the Garden to be alone with our Lord.</p>	<p>Slow down ... take you foot off the pedal and enjoy a time of quiet personal time with our Lord. Meditate on your journey thus far ... chat with our Lord about your journey ... and perhaps ask for his guidance for the rest of your trip.</p>	
<p>April 19th noon and 7:00 pm</p>	<p>Good Friday The service of the death of Jesus on the Cross.</p>	<p>We drive into the passion ... the street is full of people watching Jesus carrying a cross and eventually is nailed to the cross and dies. A riveting performance takes place at the 7:00pm Service</p>	
<p>April 20th 8:00pm Easter Celebration</p>	<p>Celebrating the Resurrection of our Lord ... a festive time of smells, bells, fabulous hymns of great joy. With a champagne party afterwards.</p>	<p>Our journey stops here if you attend this service ... you now get to celebrate your journey and all that happened on the ride. Hopefully you and our Lord are a bit closer and you know a little more about Him and His love for you ... after all dying on the cross says it all ... We are love so very much ... more than we can fathom</p>
