

ORDINANCE NO. 83-2
(As Amended September 3, 1986 and Further Amended December 2, 1987)

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATES FOR THE USE AND SERVICES OF THE WATER WORKS SYSTEM OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAPIN, AND PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAPIN, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

WHEREAS, the Village of Chapin, Illinois, under and pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. W-5 of the Village of Chapin, Illinois, passed and approved on the 11th day of May, 1955, has provided for the construction of a Water Works Plant and Distribution System of the Village of Chapin, Illinois, and for the operation of a Water Works System; and further has provided for the issuance of Water Revenue Bonds for the purpose of defraying a part of the costs of the construction of said improvement, all in accordance with the statute in such cases made and provided; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that said Village now establish rates and charges for the use of such Water Works System and provide for the collection thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chapin, Morgan County, Illinois:

SECTION 1: That the rates or charges for the services of the Water Works System of the Village of Chapin shall be as follows:

RESIDENTIAL RATE

1500 Gallon Minimum Charge 4.70
0 - 1500 Gallons at 3.15/1000 Gallons
1500 - 3000 Gallons at 2.20/1000 Gallons
over - 3000 Gallons at 1.90/1000 Gallons

COMMERCIAL & INSTITUTIONAL RATE

3000 Gallon Minimum 9.40
0 - 3000 Gallons at 3.15/1000 Gallons
3000 - 10,000 Gallons at 2.20/1000 Gallons
over - 10,000 Gallons at 1.90/1000 Gallons

BULK RATE

3.15 per 1000 Gallons

SECTION 2: That the rate to be applied to each customer shall be initially determined by the Superintendent of the Village Water Works. The customer may appeal said classification to the Village Board by written petition. The governing principals of determining whether or not the commercial and institutional rate is to be applied shall be:

- (a) Use by a business enterprise or institution substantially in excess of that normally used by a family of four; or,
- (b) Use of water as a necessary part of a business enterprise conducted for profit.

SECTION 3: The Village Board shall be expressly authorized to apply special rates in order to attract and retain industry and business to and in the Village of Chapin.

SECTION 4: That the foregoing charges shall be payable on the 1st day of each month succeeding the month during which such service was furnished or available. If any such charge be not paid by the 12th day of the month in which it is due, a penalty of 10% of the amount due shall be added to such monthly bill and collected thereon.

SECTION 5: (a) All new customers, and all customers who have their water service disconnected, for non-payment of water and sewer charges, shall be required to pay a thirty-five dollar (\$35.00) deposit to guarantee payment of subsequent water and sewer charges. Such customer's water shall not be turned on until the Village Clerk has received such deposit.

(b) Deposits shall be refunded when a customer who has paid all water and sewer charges in full moves from his residence.

SECTION 6: In the event charges for the services of the Water Works System for water are not paid within thirty (30) days after rendition of the bill for such services, such charges shall be deemed to be, and hereby are declared to be delinquent and thereafter such delinquent charges shall constitute a lien upon the real estate for

SECTION 2: That the rate to be applied to each customer shall be initially determined for the Superintendent of the Village Water Works. The customer may appeal said classification to the Village Board by written petition. The governing principle of determining whether or not the commercial and industrial rate is to be applied shall be:

- (a) Use of water as a business enterprise or for the production of profit.
- (b) Use of water as a necessary part of a business enterprise conducted for profit.

SECTION 3: The Village Board shall be expressly authorized to apply special rates in order to attract and retain industry and business to and in the Village of Chapin.

SECTION 4: That the preceding charges shall be payable on the 1st day of each month succeeding the month during which such service was furnished or available. If any such charge be not paid by the 15th day of the month in which it is due, a penalty of 1% of the amount due shall be added to such monthly bill and collected thereon.

SECTION 5: (a) All new customers and all customers who have their water service disconnected, for non-payment of water and sewer charges, shall be required to pay a thirty-five dollar (\$35.00) deposit to guarantee payment of subsequent water and sewer charges. Such customer's water shall not be turned on until the Village Clerk has received such deposit.

(b) Deposits shall be refunded when a customer who has paid all water and sewer charges in full moves from his residence.

SECTION 6: In the event charges for the services of the Water Works System for water are not paid within thirty (30) days after rendition of the bill for such services, such charges shall be deemed to be delinquent and thereby are deemed to be delinquent and thereafter such delinquent charges shall constitute a lien upon the real estate for

which service, or services were supplied. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to file sworn statements showing such delinquency in the office of the Recorder of Morgan County, Illinois, and the filing of such statements shall be deemed notice for the payment of such charges for such service or services. If the delinquency in the payment of charges continues for a period of more than thirty (30) days after such delinquent date, such service shall be discontinued.

SECTION 7: It is hereby made the duty of the Village Clerk of the Village of Chapin, Illinois, or any other Village employee duly appointed by the President and Board of Trustees to render bills for the water service, and other charges in connection therewith, and to collect all moneys due therefor.

SECTION 8: All revenues and moneys derived from the operation of the Water Works System shall be held, managed and deposited in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No. W-5 of the Village of Chapin, Illinois, passed and approved on the 11th day of May, 1955.

SECTION 9: That the rates and charges prescribed by this Ordinance go into effect on the 15th day of January, 1988.

SECTION 10: If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 11: All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Village of Chapin, Illinois, conflicting with this ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

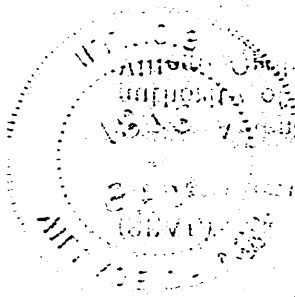
