



Martin Luther

"God created the world out of nothing, and so long as we are nothing, He can make something out of us."

Born: 1483 Eisleben, County of Mansfeld, Holy Roman Empire

Luther was a German theology professor, composer, monk, priest and an important figure in the Protestant Reformation. He has had an influential touch upon Christianity through his numerous sermons, works and penned literature. Studying the books of Hebrews, Romans and Galatians he came to understand that the salvation of man solely relies upon God with one of the most important doctrines being that of justification; God declaring by His gracious act that faith alone, makes a sinner righteous. Luther has written that "this is why faith alone makes someone just and fulfills the law. It is faith that brings the Holy Spirit through the merits of Christ." Others have written about Luther that he saw "faith as a gift from God; the experience of being justified by faith was as though he had been born again." Many of Luther's works are still available today.

Monday: 11.26 - 1 Corinthians 6:19-20

- ¹⁹ What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?
- ²⁰ For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

Prayer: Lord, help us to remember as we go though our day that we belong to you and because of this, your Holy Spirit lives within us because of your love for us.







Tuesday: 11.27 - John 8:12

Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.

Question: What does "shall not walk in darkness mean to you? Explain what the light of life illuminates in every follower/believer.



Wednesday: 11.28 - Psalms 19:14

Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O LORD, my strength, and my redeemer.

Question: Although everyone needs to be careful about what is spoken, why is God so concerned about the thoughts of our heart? What do you need to do to improve the thoughts or meditation of your heart so it will continue to be pleasing to God?



Thursday: 11.29 - Romans 15:5-6

- ⁵ Now the God of patience and consolation grant you to be likeminded one toward another according to Christ Jesus:
- ⁶ That ye may with one mind and one mouth to glorify God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Prayer: It is your presence, your mind in us that propels us to be likeminded to each other so we may praise you in one accord. Remove anything in us that would get in the way of you.



Friday: 11.30 - 2 Timothy 2:15

Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

Question: Do you schedule time everyday to read the word of God and to pray? If not, what do you need to do to begin scheduling these spiritually important love tasks everyday?



(why called love tasks? because our love for God should be so strong that we are eager to set time aside everyday to spend time with Him through reading His word and communicating with Him in prayer)

Saturday: 12.1 - James 2:23

And the scripture was fulfilled which saith, Abraham believed God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God.

Question: Do you believe that you are a friend of God? If not, what do you need to do to put more faith and trust in God?



Sunday: 12.2 - Ephesians 1:3

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ.

Question: What spiritual blessing have you received? What do you believe you need to do to receive even more of God's spiritual blessings?
