Cri tique /kriˈtēk/

Noun; a detailed analysis and assessment of something, especially a literary, philosophical, or political theory.

Similar: Analysis, evaluation, assessment, appraisal, appreciation, review, write-up, criticism, critical essay, textual examination, commentary, study, treatise, discourse, exposition, disquisition, account, exegesis, anatomization

Verb; evaluate (a theory or practice) in a detailed and analytical way. "the authors critique the methods and practices used in the research"

Ex plore /ik splôr/

Verb

• travel in or through (an unfamiliar country or area) in order to learn about or familiarize oneself with it.

"the best way to explore Iceland's northwest"

Similar: travel over, tour, traverse, range over, survey, take a look at, inspect, investigate, scout, reconnoiter, search, prospect, recce, give something a/the once-over, give something a look-see, give something a going-over

• search for resources such as mineral deposits.

"the company explored for oil"

- inquire into or discuss (a subject or issue) in detail.
- "he sets out to explore fundamental questions"

Bring your artwork, old, new, unfinished, barely thought of, and let it be placed on a comfy chopping block of your peers and creative equals and softly cut to small bits where soon after it will be stitched back together with delicate refinement.

What I mean is it helps to run your ideas by other humans. The critique process isn't always painful but it is always helpful if you allow it to be. Being able to defend your artwork is what makes it worth something. Give your creativity weight by being able to guide viewers through your world and become a better creative by being able to believe in yourself and be objective.
