### Pottawatomie County

From May 1 to May 31,

**Residents** can drop off passenger tires and refrigeration appliances at no cost. You will be asked for your address before you can drop off the items.

You must be able to tell us what you are bringing or provide us with a list of items.

There will be a fee of 50% of the normal rate for all other non-passenger vehicle tires. All loads must be secured or tarped.

#### No-Cost Items eligible for drop off:

Pickup & Passenger tires (with or without rim) Refrigerators, Freezers, Air Conditioner Units, Dehumidifiers and Coolers
