## REMINDER HURRICANE SEASON STARTS JUNE 1ST

### HURRICANE SHUTTERS

#### OCCUPIED STRUCTURES:

APPROVED ( DCA) METAL OR PVC SHUTTERS MAY BE INSTALLED ON OCCUPIED STRUCTURES ON THE BACK AND SIDE OF THE STRUCTURE. FRONT SHUTTERS CAN ONLY BE PUT IN PLACE NINETY-SIX ( 96) HOURS BEFORE A NAMED TROPICAL STORM IS FORECAST TO IMPACT THE AREA AND MUST BE REMOVED NINETY-SIX HOURS AFTER A STORM HAS CLEARED THE AREA .

#### UNOCCUPIED STRUCTURES:

APPROVED ( DCA) METAL OR PVC SHUTTERS MAY BE INSTALLED ON UNOCCUPIED STRUCTURES AND MUST BE REMOVED UPON OWNERS RETURNING TO THE AREA . CONSISTENT WITH THE RULES

SEE CHARLOTTE COUNTY, FL CODE OF ORDINANCES SECTION 2-1-44 REMOVAL OF STORM SHUTTERS.
