REMINDER HURRICANE SEASON STARTS JUNE 1ST HURRICANE SHUTTERS

OCCUPIED STRUCTURES:

APPROVED (DCA) METAL OR PVC SHUTTERS MAY BE INSTALLED ON OCCUPIED STRUCTURES ON THE BACK AND SIDE OF THE STRUCTURE. FRONT SHUTTERS CAN ONLY BE PUT IN PLACE NINETY—SIX (96) HOURS BEFORE A NAMED TROPICAL STORM IS FORECAST TO IMPACT THE AREA AND MUST BE REMOVED NINETY—SIX HOURS AFTER A STORM HAS CLEARED THE AREA.

UNOCCUPIED STRUCTURES:

APPROVED (DCA) METAL OR PVC SHUTTERS MAY BE INSTALLED ON UNOCCUPIED STRUCTURES AND MUST BE REMOVED UPON OWNERS
RETURNING TO THE AREA CONSISTENT WITH THE RULES
