

Pennsylvania Jural Assembly governance:

The Pennsylvania Jural Assembly uses the Verified Meeting Minutes of A Jural Assembly of State for nominations and elections for the districts. They also use the same Certification Of Accuracy, Verified Affidavit, and Notary public Acknowledgment. The communities all follow the same forms and format which is described herein and below in class 7.

No one mankind can hold two titles or office.  
So a delegate cannot be a secretary. A sheriff cannot also be a scribe and so on.

We have no state, no district, no county governance. We only have community governance. All international governance is through the Congress Assembled.

An officer or delegate can be removed from office by a grand jury approval for misconduct.

Delegate: delegate is a term used until the government is returned to ruling status. Then Delegates become Senators of their State, District, or County. The delegate is the nation-state leader and administrator/servant. The delegate's duties are the research, the leg work, the teaching, the education, they get everything the people need and they present it to the communities.

The state delegate's gather all information about every subject state-wide from the districts at the state level and freely giving that information out to the communities and local delegates through the district delegates or as required.

The district delegate gathers all information about every subject local, state, and district-wide from the counties, districts, and state at the district level and freely giving that information out to the communities through the local delegates first, or as required.

The local delegate gathers all information about every subject state, district, county-wide from the county and district and state at the local level and freely giving that information out to the communities and other delegates. Delegates are the intermediaries between commercial and dejure as commercial entities are not able to speak to the living mankind. Therefore the delegates and local officers and secretary work to establish Law, rules, and guidelines for all commercial operations within the communities.

Jural Assembly secretary - keeper of the original nation- state documents.

Districts and counties:

**Notary:** The notary replaces the defacto office of judge. The Notary is the common law judge. Reads the administrative action on paper and makes the determination who followed the law and dishes out the result (punishment).

**Sheriff:** The Sheriff is the Justice of the Peace. The duties of the Sheriff are keeps the peace. Also during times and space of accidents, emergencies, disasters is in charge of relief efforts. Sheriff is in charge of the militia. Helps notary to organize and empanel the common Law grand jury and oversees the efforts of the grand jury providing what is required by the grand jury.

**Commissioner:** The commissioner replaces the defacto treasurer. The duties of the commissioner are treasurer, trusted with the monetary system whether it's banking or building infrastructure, bids, etc. Commissioner helps the Common Good infrastructure.

**Scribe:** The duties of the scribe are keeps records of community events, records births, deeds, marriages, etc.

**Community secretary** - keeps minutes for the community and help the other four offices by keeping one set of books open to the public upon request.

**Governance:** Governance starts at the very basic level of family.

1. A group of 10 families gather and decide together what they want. This can be Law or rules pertaining to any issue.
2. One person is chosen to share information from their community which is the family delegate.
3. The family delegate shares information with the 50 family group of delegates, then 100 group, and so on up.
4. There is only one county delegate from each community that takes information to the 2 district delegates who in turn returns the information back to the original small communities and so on. This affords a free flowing river of information and energies within the communities.

**Note:** The community builder class is number 7 found on the PCLGJA forums pages and the Common Good videos. It is mandatory to watch those Common Good videos. It explains everything. The petitions are written out with class 7. Do not re-write your own, use the format that is provided so we all use the same formats.

## NOTES FOR THE COLONIES - Pennsylvania

In order to fill a position of

1. Scribe (Recorder),
2. Notary (Judge)
3. Justice of the Peace (Sheriff)
4. Commissioner (Treasurer)

The man or woman desiring to hold the position of one of the above named offices of your county, please use the appropriate petition. Make 10 copies of the Petition. As autographs are collected and total 25, number the page at the bottom in the appropriate order. Obtain 250 signatures in your county. Record the Petition into the County Recorder of Deeds.

Obtain a certified copy from the Recorder.

Make a copy of the certified copy and send to the Secretary of your State, giving notice that you are filling this vacancy.

The men and women of each County will be responsible for governing themselves. Therefore, there will be a position of Notary, Commissioner, Scribe and Sheriff and district for every county and district throughout your new state.

Be certain to educate before and while filling the position. There are numerous groups throughout the land that are already in session educating themselves and others. Take advantage of their preparation.
