**Dunedin Highland Parade Details - Friday 4 April:** 


- 4:30 p.m. Dinner at The Honu (516 Grant St. Dunedin see below for more info) pups welcome!
- 5:45 p.m. Meet at City Hall parking lot 737 Louden St. We are spot 27 and lineup numbers will be laid out in the parking lot.
- 6:30 p.m. Parade step off!
- Parade starts at Caledonia Brewing,
  down Main St, and left to Rosie's Tavern
  (730 Broadway, Dunedin)
- Parade is 15-20 min max 0.4 miles



**Parking:** The Monroe Street Parking Garage (FREE), 356 Monroe St, Dunedin, FL is about 0.2 mi from the start of the parade / Honu. See <u>Downtown Dunedin Public Parking | Dunedin, FL</u> (dunedingov.com) for other parking options/pricing.

- See map on the next page. Blue line is the parade route, starting on Louden Ave and going down Main Street. The Honu is highlighted and we will eat outside. Don't forget to order from their Pup Menu for the wee Scot!!
- Note this is after daylight saving's time change, so we will be done before dark!
- Feel free to dress your Scottie in their best Scottish attire for the event, or select a festive leash. I'll have tartan sashes for any pups that want to wear them costumes are NOT required.
