Paper:

One pad of drawing paper (bristol, plate vellum or smooth) 9" x 12" or 11" x 14". Hot press or smooth watercolor paper can also be used.

Pencil:

HB or 2H, or mechanical pencil and appropriate eraser.

Disposable archival pens:

Disposable pens in black waterproof ink. They come in various sizes and in sets. Suggested sizes, .01, .03 and .05.

Some brand names are as follows: Micron Pigma, Nexus, Prismacolor fine line markers, Alvin Penstik India Ink drawing pen, Faber Castell Pitt Artist Drawing Pen sets.

Brush:

One inexpensive watercolor brush for washes.

Optional traditional tools:

Ink:

One small bottle of black India ink, waterproof and permanent (Higgins, Pelikan, FW, etc). If you prefer, you may use brown sepia ink.

Pen and nibs:

One dip pen-holder and 2 or 3 crowquill nibs. (Make sure the nib fits into the holder).

Bamboo or reed pen (any size)
