- 5. Profit & Loss Statement, Profit & Loss Year to Date Comparison, Profit & Loss Previous Year Comparison, and Profit & Loss Detail for July 2021. Reviewed and Discussed. Motion to accept made by Robert VonGonten, seconded by James Cargill motion passed.

- 10. Discuss for Action: Non-Standard Service Agreement for Rockdale Country Club Estates II. Mr. Randy Fletcher present to represent the Rockdale Country Club. Discussed that the Country Club has been here since Alcoa and their current situation. The project is for 7 lots on 7.5 acres along FM 2116; they do have more land for the future. Mr. Fletcher is asking for approval for 9 meters (originally asked for 9 meters), however; the additional 2 are not plotted and there is a guarantee for 30 days after approval. The 7 meters will be \$3,700.00 each and they are requesting that if they must come in later for the additional 2 meters if they could also be approved at \$3,700.00 each.  - FM 908-12" project-Road Bore on FM 487 at Rockdale Well / shop complete. Crew is working on connecting new 12" line into Rockdale Well plant.
 - Continue to work on loan information for CoBank-waiting on pricing figures from Engineer to complete and submit back to CoBank.
 - All three new trucks are in service.
 - New Conex at shop has been delivered.
 - New Equipment-SW Milam will need a new Skid-Steer or Front-End loader and a new mini-x. Reviewed cost estimate examples.
 - Sandoval Plant-Fill volume is deficient, need larger pumps at either Thorndale or 908 Plants or both. Also, larger pipes from both plants to Sandoval.
 - Lina Plant-The distribution pumps have reached capacity and will need to be upgraded as soon as possible.
