Chaplain's Message

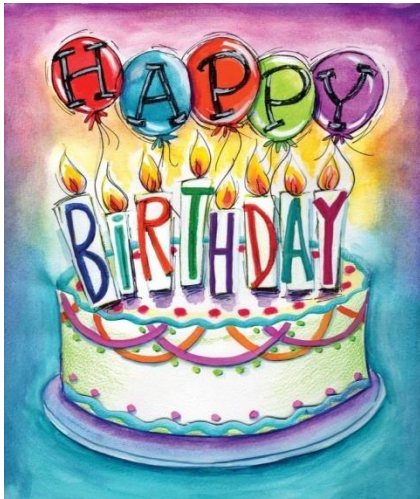
The Mad Dog Car Club is very grateful and appreciative of everything that CCC did to help make the show a success.

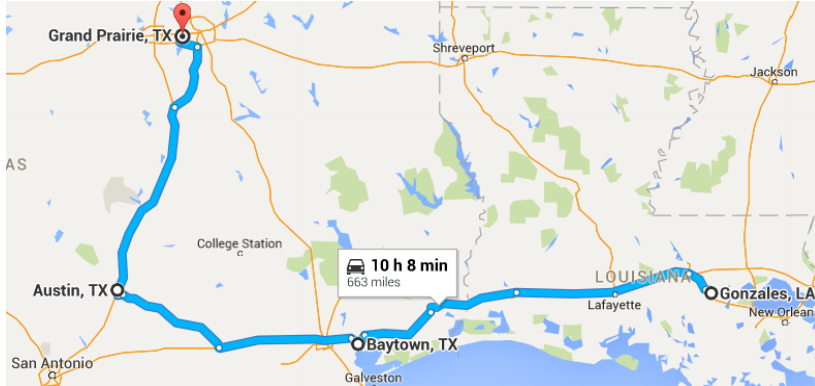
Hi Folks,

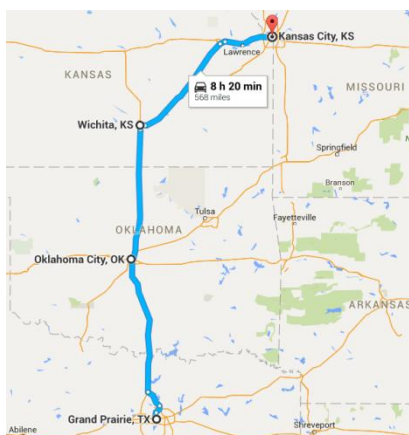

June 17 - Kansas Speedway, Kansas City, KS



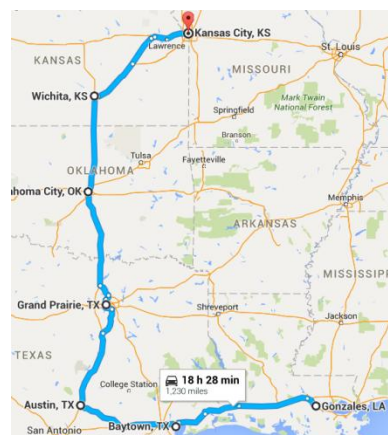
Since it goes through DFW mid week, we could do just the 1st half of the route

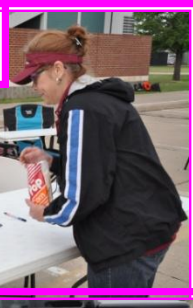
