Utility Line Locator Exam

The Department of Public Utilities is seeking qualified candidates for the position of Utility Line Locator. To apply, one must first take the open-competitive examination. Applications may be submitted to the Civil Service Commission by applying online at [www.csc.columbus.gov](http://www.csc.columbus.gov) by 2/15/2019. Applicant tracking is now managed by NEOGOV. If you have submitted a profile in the past, you will have to submit a new one through NEOGOV.

This position is responsible for locating underground utility lines. To qualify candidates must have two (2) years of experience locating, installing, and/or inspecting utility lines. Possession of a valid driver's license is required. Salary: \$44,345.60 - \$54,953.60. Please contact the Civil Service Commission at 645-8300 with questions. EOE.
