2. A **one-page essay** must be included with your application and should include the following: Applicant Name, Tribe, School, Area of Study, Goals and Future Plans, and response to the following Question Prompt: *How has your JOM program has supported your PreK-12 school experience?*
3. Verification of Tribal Enrollment (Certificate of Indian Blood, CDIB, Tribal ID, Enrollment Letter, etc.)
4. Current Photo (By uploading a photo, you agree to allow the image to be used for publishing purposes)
5. Current transcript (official or unofficial accepted)
