Praise Report to the Glory of God! By Wade Anderson

Let's pray: "Gracious and Almighty heavenly Father, I thank You for Your Word which is the seed, and when planted deep in our hearts will produce a crop of right living, from the inside out. I thank You for Your promised Holy Spirit that You promised is alive and living in each and every one of Your children, us! We love You Lord! I thank You for Your guidance and Your healing power in my life. You, Sir, have NEVER let me down and have ALWAYS been faithful to Your Word. It's in Jesus' name I pray and believe. Amen! Amen! "

It's been a couple of months now, so I decided to sit down here at my desk and give you all a praise report from my own personal life. As you all may remember, in the December issue of the newsletter, I mentioned how I love the Christmas season and usually decorate our home BRIGHTLY for the glory of God. Well, that was the plan ...

On November 4th, I woke up at 6:00am to get ready to head up on the roof and trim some tree branches out of the way, in order to place the lights on the entire roof. Heading outside it was now about 7:30am. Inside of 15 minutes on the roof I realized the task would be much easier with a cordless saw-zaw. I went back over the roof and onto the ladder. I made it down about four steps when the feet on the ladder decided to start sliding away with me on it. The next 45 seconds seemed to take forever as I watched myself headed to the ground. Even as I was sliding with my feet still on the rungs, I kept saying, out loud, "Lord, NO! Lord, don't let this be a disaster! NO! Don't allow this to interfere with my left hip replacement." And this is how God did exactly as I asked.

Last year, I'd built a new 20' x 20' shop with a 5' vaulted area above with pull downstairs for attic storage. I built this on to the already 20' x 20' existing shop. The complete shop is now 20'x 40'. In the previous months to the ladder incident, I'd been building out the inside the way that I wanted to set up all of my machines. I had the concrete poured 23 years earlier with this vision in my heart this entire time, and now it was a reality!

Every other time I've set the ladder up to climb up on a roof, I always put a 50lb weight behind each foot of the ladder. As I set the ladder in place this time, I did have a quickening to do the same, but didn't! The climb up was just fine, but evidently the ladder was at too steep of an angle and as soon as I started down it caused the weight on the top to push the bottom feet away from the house. The top of the ladder slid down the roof until it came to the edge and DROPPED DOWN, with my 235lb body weight, until it hit the block window stoop with a FORCE! With my right foot still on the ladder rung and my left foot wrapped in the ladder, at the point I hit the window stoop it turned into a DEAD STOP and it threw my body sideways and onto the concrete walkway.

While I was first falling backwards, I hit the top of my head on an existing water pipe and spicket, causing it to break off and SHOOT water everywhere! That water line was 7" outside of the new building I'd built. So, what does that mean? That means that had I hit 1" further to the right I could have hit my head on the corner of that building and possibly split it open. I did have three large knots on my head, but it was NOT split open! Someone say, "PRAISE JESUS!" But that's not ALL. In the same area where I landed, I had two huge steel vises, mounted on 4" steel pipe with thick steel bases, waiting to be painted and taken into the new shop. In the same area I'd stacked other types of metal, sawhorses, and a metal safe-like cabinet I had planned to use inside. All of this was in my landing area. BUT I landed precisely between it all!

Hitting the ground just outside our bedroom window with my adrenaline pumping, the water spewing in the air, and my body already feeling like I'd been wound through a ringer, I yelled to Michelle, "COME TURN THE WATER OFF!!" As she ran outside, she seen me sitting there on the ground in the water. With her not knowing where the shut off valve was, I directed her to where it was and said to her, "Look at the level I will go just to teach you where the water shut off is!" She laughed and then asked me if I could get up. Again, with the adrenaline pumping I attempted to stand up and nearly fell again. Michelle asked if I needed an ambulance, and I said no. At that point she immediately ran into the house and got the walker I used 12 years ago with the hip replacement. With no weight on the right leg, I was able to hobble my way into the house, change my wet shirt and jacket and then make it out to the car.

All the way to the hospital Michelle and I both kept thanking God for His hand of protection in all of this! Arriving to the ER by 8:30am I quickly seen that the WAIT would be a long one. After an hour or more in the waiting room, they took us back in the ER room to see a doctor. Seeing the knots on my head they immediately sent me in for a CT scan to make sure there was no internal bleeding. With this 'melon' of mine hitting the asphalt many other times I was pretty sure it would be just fine. The CT scan of my head came back as I'd believed it would. After a while they took me for x-rays on the rest of my body. It all came back great, except for a couple faint lines on my right ankle area. While lying there waiting, staying in a good frame of mind, and thinking about NO Christmas lights, I had Michelle get online and order a HUGE 11' 6" tall blow-up Grinch! I figured with that in the front yard it would tell the neighbors why the Christmas lights were not up, the Grinch stole them.

It was now about three o'clock in the afternoon when the on-staff ER doctor came in and told us he had contacted and sent the x-rays to a Podiatric Surgery Specialist (foot doctor) to look at. Still in the ER, it was about 7:00pm when that

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surgeon came to the hospital to review the x-rays with us and give us his plan. He also told us that this time of year he always has at least three or more ladder related falls and operations to do. "Some people are not as lucky as you," he said. And went on to say, "Many people die from falls like the one you had." After revealing that the heel was indeed fractured in three places, he stated that he would schedule me for surgery, but not until the next afternoon. After he left the staff doctor came back in and told us they were getting a room ready, but it could be several more hours before I was taken upstairs. It was now about 10:30pm so I assured Michelle there was nothing else she could do, I would be just fine, and I sent her home to get some sleep. It was now 11:30pm, and after fifteen hours in the ER they came and transferred me to my room.

In my relationship and life experiences with God, I always know that He can and does use me wherever I land, whether on my feet or on my back! So, when I arrived at the hospital, I had my spiritual eyes and ears open to receive His direction. Even as the nurses were taking me through the halls to my room, I was sharing how good God was that this heel thing was all I'd experienced. I was finally in my room and settled by 12:30am. By 6:30am the day shift nurses were coming on duty, and I quickly realized that God had directed specific nurses on two shifts, the full three days of my stay, to hear the Good News about Jesus. Being told I would be there for a couple of days I gave Michelle a few hours to rest before I called and asked her to bring me my Bible, a few different issues of newsletters, a couple family pictures to hang on the wall, and some lounge pants and t-shirts. As the days went on, I started to wonder if I was going to get these nurses in trouble for being in my room so long talking about Jesus. I quickly realized, if God had directed them to hear the Good News, He would most assuredly keep them safe from loosing their jobs, and I kept sharing Jesus with them.

Through the day I kept asking the nurses when I was going to have the operation. They only told me, "The surgeon would be in soon to let me know." It was about 1:00 pm when he did come in and told me we were headed for surgery at 6:00 pm. At 6:00 pm they came to take me to surgery, where I then was told it wouldn't happen until 8:00 pm. He told me he decided we would be the last ones into surgery, so that he could take his time and get all the pieces back where they are supposed to be. What was supposed to be a 2 ½ - 3 hour surgery turned into 4 hours! At the end of the surgery, I ended up with a plate and nine screws in my heel. On Sunday, I went home with the instructions that I would be off my foot for 8-10 weeks. That's when I said, "Maybe you don't know my Jesus."

I will be the first to admit that this heel injury was WAY more intense than the complete Hip replacement I went through. As the days went on, I began to realize just how many of my other body parts had been twisted in the fall. Being someone that is generally always busy, I now found myself laid up in a bed barely moving at all. I started out in a 'boot' on a knee scooter, which by the way had a basket on it, a squeeze horn AND Christmas lights. I felt like the kids, flying up and down the halls running the wheels off of it. After six weeks, the doc still had me in a bandage and a 'boot' but now with light weight and a walker. About four weeks ago, he released me for light local driving and to physical therapy, two times a week. This progressed to no 'boot' and a cane.

At this point, thirteen weeks from surgery, ALL of the modes of 'get along transportation' have been boxed up and put away. I have been in BOTH my shoes for a few weeks now, and I only have two more physical therapy sessions next week. Not often, but I'm now working a couple hours at a time out in the shop, building my strength and confidence to get back on my motorcycles and ride again. By the time you all read this, all of it will be in the past.

My intent with this praise report is to of course give Jesus Praise, but as well to encourage someone out there that; While in the middle of trials and hurdles it always seems like such a long time to the other side of it. Yes, about the 8th week into all of this I was the same way. It 'felt' like it had been so long, but in it all I know that God doesn't promise any of it will be easy. What He does promise however is that we have victory in Him, when we choose to not grow weary and faint, we will reap a harvest in due season. And we all know that some seasons have a longer gestation period, right? We can't allow our 'feelings' to dictate our outcome. Jesus is the same yesterday, today and forever, AMEN? Through all of this Michelle has been my angel and my rock for all of my needs. She waited on me hand and 'foot' while I couldn't do much for myself. She carted me around from one appointment to another without hesitation. Even at that 8th week mark, when I was a little discouraged, she encouraged me that I was almost to the other side of it all. Of course, I love Jesus more than anything else in this world. Yes, even Michelle. But she also wouldn't have it any other way. Michelle knows that if I don't put Jesus above EVERYTHING I will never love her the way Christ loved the church! I'm sure she would willingly and gratefully tell you, "I loved that other guy for thirteen years before Jesus and there is no comparison to these last almost sixteen years WITH Jesus!"

Oh yah, I almost forgot. The second week I was home from surgery I asked my grandson, Caleb, to come over and climb in the shop attic to take down all of the yard blow-ups and other lights, which he did. The next week I contacted this young brother in Christ and friend about coming over and putting the two rows of lights on the gutters of the house. Within a couple of days, him and his girlfriend came and put them up in just a couple of hours. A day or so later I had a little cabin

Foot's Bible Study

Ezekiel 21:1-23:49

The leaders, whom God chose, were responsible for the moral climate of the nation. The same is true today. See James 3:1, "My brethren, let not many of you become teachers, knowing that we shall receive a stricter judgment." Unfortunately, many of the same sins mentioned here have been committed in recent years by Christian leaders. We are living in a time of unprecedented attacks by satan. We must uphold our leaders in prayer, and leaders must seek accountability in order to help them maintain their moral and spiritual integrity. (22:6-13)

The Israelites went so far as to sacrifice their own children to idols and then to sacrifice to the Lord the same day. This made a mockery of worship. We cannot praise God and willfully sin at the same time. That would be like going to bed with a neighbor and then celebrating one's wedding anniversary. (23:29)

Hebrews 10:1-39

Christ came to offer His body on the Cross for us as a sacrifice that is completely acceptable to God. God's new and living way for us to please Him is not by keeping laws or even by abstaining from sin. It is by coming to Him in faith to be forgiven, and then following Him in loving obedience. (10:5-10)

Hebrews encourages believers to persevere in their Christian faith and conduct when facing persecution and pressure. We don't usually think of suffering as good for us, but it can build our character and our patience. During times of great stress, we may find God's presence more clearly and find help from Christians we never thought would care. Knowing that Jesus is with us in our suffering and that He will return one day to put an end to all pain helps us grow in our faith and our relationship with Him. See Romans 5:3-5, "And not only that, but we also glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance; and perseverance, character; and character, hope. Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us." (10:32-36)

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Psalms 108:1-109:31

Do our prayers end with requests for help to make it through stressful situations? David prayed not merely for rescue but for victory. With God's help we can claim more than mere survival, we can claim victory! Look for ways God can use your distress as an opportunity to show His mighty power. (108:13)

David was angry at being attacked by evil people who slandered him and lied. Yet David remained a friend and man of prayer. While we must hate evil and work to overcome it, we must love everyone, including those who do evil, because God loves them we are called to hate the sin, but love the person. Only through God's strength will we be able to follow David's example. (109:4)

Proverbs 27:12-13

A diligent person will look ahead of where he or she is going and take precautions to avoid any danger where a lazy person just stumbles along blindly and ends up suffering all kinds of consequences and repercussions for their poor planning. (27:12)

Make sure to get collateral from anyone who guarantees the debt of a stranger, some form of a deposit so you will be sure to cover yourself from loss. (27:13)
