## ORDINANCE NO. 2013-9

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF CLOVERDALE, INDIANA CREATING A DEPARTMENT OF STORM WATER MANAGEMENT AND A SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, I.C. 8-1.5-5-1 et seq. allows municipalities to adopt the provisions of said chapter by ordinance thus creating a Department of Stormwater Management and a special taxing district;

WHEREAS, the Town of Cloverdale has reviewed the advantages and disadvantages of establishing such a Department and desires to create a Department of Stormwater Management and a special taxing district within the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF CLOVERDALE, INDIANA:

Section 1. A Department of Stormwater Management is hereby established for the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana,

Section 2. The Storm Water Utility shall be controlled by a Board of Directors as set out in I.C. 8-1.5-5-4. The Board consists of three members appointed by the President of the Town Council. Not more than two of the Board Members may be of the same political party.

Section 3. The terms of office of the Directors shall be three (3) years. The initial terms of the Board shall consist of One (1) term to run until December 31, 1014, One (1) term to run until December 31, 1015 and one (1) term to run until December 31, 2016. An appointment shall be made of a three (3) year term each effective January 1 of each year replacing the expiring members term. Members may be appointed to successive terms.

Section 3. The Directors created pursuant to the terms of this ordinance shall have those powers provided for under I.C. 8-1.5-5-1, as the same may be amended from time to time, which are as follows:

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effective upon passage.
