Some Achievements require a public <u>vote</u> which will require a 51% majority. Some require a private vote, which should be written down and concealed. *** NOTES: 1. "23" reads as "3 or more." 2. For post game achievements, make notes during the game if needed. 3. "Constant" Achievements are the same on EVERY list, the rest vary list to list. 4. A complete round is from the start of someones turn until the start of their next turn. 5. CONSTANT (M)	*3*	<b>It just keeps going and going and going...</b> <small>Energizer Bunny (TV Commercial, 1989-?)</small>	<i>Either take a turn of 5+ minutes or take more than 1 extra turns/phases in a row (-1pt per extra turn/phase)</i>	-1pt						
	*4*	<b>Bogus. Heinous. Most non-triumphant</b> <small>Bill &amp; Ted's Excellent Adventure (Movie, 1989)</small>	<i>Eliminate a player prior to their 5th turn (-4pts PER player you eliminate BEFORE their 5th turn)</i>	-4pts						
	*5*	<b>Ha ha! You fool! You fell victim to one of the classic blunders - the most famous of which is "Never get involved in a land war in Asia"</b> <small>The Princess Bride (Movie, 1987)</small>	<i>At each turn's cleanup step, lose 1pt for each land you destroyed this turn, BEYOND the first land you destroyed this turn (THIS DOES NOT USE THE STACK)</i>	-Xpts						
ONLY ONCE PER ROUND (1)	1	<b>And then. And then. And then. ... And theeeeeeeeeen</b> <small>Dude, Where's My Car? (Movie, 2000)</small>	<i>Be the first player to cast ≥5 spells in one turn (NO AND THEN --&gt; 1pt for ANYONE that counters/fizzles an opponent's 3rd (or greater) spell in a turn)</i>	2pts						
	2	<b>Do you want to build a snowman?</b> <small>Frozen (Movie, 2013)</small>	<i>Be the first player to control a snow permanent</i>	1pt						
	3	<b>I am legend</b> <small>I Am Legend (Movie, 2007)</small>	<i>Be the first player to have ≥4 legendary permanents in play under your control</i>	2pts						
	4	<b>It takes 2 to make a thing go right</b> <small>It Takes Two - Rob Base &amp; DJ EZ Rock (Music, 1988)</small>	<i>Be the first player to have 2 creatures with "Partner" or "Partner with" in play</i>	1pt						
	5	<b>My Precious</b> <small>The Lord of the Rings: The Two Towers (Movie, 2002)</small>	<i>Be the first player to control a Sol Ring</i>	1pt						
	6	<b>Run Forrest, RUN!</b> <small>Forrest Gump (Movie, 1994)</small>	<i>Be the first player to attack with a land (Bonus 1pt if that land can produce green mana)</i>	1pt						
	7	<b>They ALL did it. But if you want to know who killed Mr. Boddy, I did it, in the hall, with the revolver</b> <small>Clue (Movie, 1985)</small>	<i>Only eliminate the last opponent, NO ONE ELSE</i>	2pts						
	8	<b>What I do have are a very particular set of skills, skills I have acquired over a very long career</b> <small>Taken (Movie, 2008)</small>	<i>Control the creature with the most (at least 2) Keywords (Awarded post game) (No ties)</i>	1pt						
	9	<b>You've got to ask yourself one question: 'Do I feel lucky?' Well, do ya punk?</b> <small>Dirty Harry (Movie, 1971)</small>	<i>Be the first player to play a spell or ability that requires an element of randomness (Die roll, coin flip, picked at random, ...)</i>	1pt						
MULTIPLE TIMES (M)	10	<b>Size really DOES matter</b> <small>If you don't get the reference I'M not explaining it</small>	<i>Cast a spell AND have an oversized card on hand to represent it (only 1pt per spell) OR Meld 2 creatures (Limit 3pts)</i>	1pt						
	11	<b>Well, according to paragraph 7, sentence 3, word 8 of the Geneva Convention... "the"</b> <small>Family Guy (TV Series, 1998-?)</small>	<i>Play a card with the word "the" in it's name (Limit 3pts)</i>	1pt						
ONLY ONCE TO EACH PLAYER (P)	12	<b>Do, or do not. There is no try</b> <small>The Empire Strikes Back (Movie, 1980)</small>	<i>Cast a spell which CANNOT be countered, OR resolve a spell through an opponent's counterspell</i>	1pt						
	13	<b>If you build it, he will come</b> <small>Field of Dreams (Movie, 1989)</small>	<i>Put any of the following creatures into play: Awoken Horror; Kaldra; Ludevic's Abomination; Marit Lage; Ormendahl; The Unspeakable; Urami; Withengar Unbound</i>	4pts						
	14	<b>Maniacal laugh, MANIACAL LAUGH</b> <small>The Muppets (Movie, 2011)</small>	<i>Successfully choose the first player to be eliminated (Before the game, each player SECRETLY picks ANY player)</i>	2pts						
	15	<b>WHAT'S IN THE BOX?</b> <small>Se7en (Movie, 1995)</small>	<i>Place a face down card in exile (Exiled cards are normally face up unless otherwise stated by the effect that exiles it)</i>	1pt						
M	16	<b>Badges? We don't need no stinking badges</b> <small>Blazing Saddles (Movie, 1974)</small>	<i>Create a token or emblem, without a copy of it on hand (-1pt per TYPE of token/emblem) (only applies if WOTC has printed appropriate tokens/emblems) (Limit -3pts)</i>	-1pt
