This Non-Language Specific six (6) credit hour course will outline and familiarize the Student with drug organizations, current trends, use, terminology and sale of illegal and prescription narcotics. From production to abuse, students will learn where and how illegal and prescription drugs are produced and distributed in the United States. Students will also become familiar with the many ways in which illegal narcotic is packaged and transferred. As part of the training curriculum, students will learn basic "Under the Influence" symptoms and associated terminology while interpreting for drug cases. Other topics to be discussed include; The ins and outs of Medicinal Marijuana (Prop 215), its associated terminology and processes. Methamphetamine, Mexican Drug Cartels, The Family Medicine Cabinet will also be discussed along with descriptions and terminology of some of today's most abused prescription drugs. Finally, the Interpreter will learn terminology and use processes for the varied drug devices, smoking apparatus and miscellaneous drug paraphernalia. ***Course may also be presented via webinar with "live" interactive Instructor facilitated participation.**
