Four-Wide 101

How four-wide drag racing works





Four-wide drag racing makes its return to the West Coast with the DENSO Spark Plugs NHRA Four-Wide

Nationals. Here's a breakdown on how a four-wide drag race operates:

Lane Designation

Lanes will be identified in numerical order from left to right facing down track. The outermost left lane will be lane No. 1, then lanes No. 2 and No. 3 will be in the middle, with the outermost right lane referred to as lane No. 4.

Track Preparation

In an attempt to maintain uniform traction quality in all four lanes, Sportsman classes, while only running two cars side-by-side, will utilize all four lanes during the entire event. Certain Sportsman classes will only run lanes No. 1 and No. 2, while other Sportsman classes will run exclusively in lanes No. 3 and No. 4. Track prep, cleanup equipment and personnel will increase accordingly.

Qualifying

For the first of four qualifying sessions, drivers with the least number of championship points will be the first to run, and the top four points leaders will be the last to run in each category. The highest in points will run in lane No. 4, second-highest in lane No. 3, third-highest in lane No. 2 and fourth-highest in lane No. 1.

Subsequent qualifying sessions will follow normal qualifying procedures, with the quickest elapsed times running last in each session. Each team will make one qualifying run in each of the four lanes.

Scoreboards

During Four Wide, the left scoreboard will represent lanes 1 & 2. Lane 1 will be the top line, Lane 2 the bottom line. The right board will represent lanes 3 & 4. Lane 3 will be the top line, Lane 4 the bottom line. As the cars cross the finish line, the elapsed time will come up first, then after two seconds, the display will change to the MPH for all lanes, and continue this rotation.

Starting System

Since The Strip is essentially two tracks built side-by-side, with a center wall separating the two all the way to the top end, each track will have the standard NHRA Christmas tree. Atop each tree will be prestage and stage LED indicators for each lane positioned in the same order as the lanes.








Canyon, and continue on to the intersection of Rte. 89A and Rte. 89. There we take a sharp left and travel through the Navajo Indian Reservation arriving in

The Birthplace of Historic Route 66

Seligman was founded in 1886 at the junction of the railroad from Prescott to the Santa Fe's main line. It was known as Prescott Junction until it was renamed after Jesse Seligman, a prominent New York banker responsible for financing railroad construction and companies. The railroad played a big part of Seligman's community for the next hundred years by establishing repair facilities and the famous Harvey House.

Seligman, the birthplace of Historic Route 66, is a small, unincorporated town situated in the beautiful Upland Mountains of Northern Arizona. In 1987, the State of Arizona dedicated old U.S. Route 66 from Seligman to Kingman as Historic Route 66, due to the efforts of the Seligman Chamber of Commerce. The dedication will assure the preservation of the longest remaining stretch of old Route 66 left in the

United States.





Bugatti unveils the most expensive new car ever built

A mystery owner has just bought Bugatti's new "hypercar." The Bugatti La Voiture Noire was sold for more than \$19 million.

Bugatti, the French sports car brand that is now owned by German automaker Volkswagen, has revealed the most expensive new car ever built.

With a sale price of 16.7 million euros (\$19 million), the Bugatti



La Voiture Noire was publicly debuted Tuesday at the Geneva International Motor Show in Switzerland.

Only one example of the model has been built and was developed to mark Bugatti's $110^{\rm th}$ anniversary.

The company said the six-tailpipe "hypercar" represents the pinnacle of Bugatti's production line. The 8-liter engine has 16 cylinders and 1500 brake horse power.

The new owner hasn't been revealed but several industry reports suggest that former Volkswagen Group chairman Ferdinand Piech has added it to his collection of high-end cars.

Bugatti says the car is "more than a modern interpretation" of Jean Bugatti's Type 57 SC Atlantic, of which only four were ever made.



Technical Issues Facing the C8 Corvette

First, all GM products are shifting to a new electrical architecture—the means by which 100 or more computer modules per vehicle communicate on what's called a CAN (computer area network) bus. Engineers are having difficulty working the bugs out of the new Global B party line serving Corvette and several other new models.



The second issue is a structural distortion of the aluminum spaceframe experienced during testing a prototype equipped with the 900-1000 horsepower twin-turbo V-8. The twist in back was enough to fracture the glass hatch covering the engine.

Item three is some unspecified bone of contention between those who design Corvettes and the development engineers who steer them to the far corners of the performance envelope. It could be a visibility issue, some ergonomic shortcoming, or a cockpit design problem.

We've heard that one of the major issues with the C8 was electrical in nature, but that's not addressed by Don unless it was Item 3 on his list which was fairly vague. Current GM President Mark Reuss talked about the Global B initiative back in 2015 which is designed to move much of the vehicle's computer power to the cloud.

Of the three issues, we find number 2 to be the most exciting. The ZORA model (which we call the highest performance variant of the C8) includes a combination of electric motors with a twin-turbo V8 to make 900-1,000 hp and apparently the massive torque was causing the twisting of a frame member and cracking the glass engine cover.

Our friend John at the <u>MidEngineCorvetteForum.com</u> says the frame issue was solved long ago with the help of GM's Cray Supercomputer which analyzed the frame structure and identified the areas that needed reinforcement. GM's plans are to use just one chassis for all C8 models so now the base "Stingray" model will have the same reinforcements as the ZORA model.

As noted, issue #3 was the vaguest and we certainly have no idea what that could have been. We do think that the recent sightings of the car with Mark Reuss in Yuma, along with Tadge, Harlan and Alex in San Diego lead us to believe whatever issue 3 was has been resolved by now as well. You don't fly the GM President half-way across the country to ride in a car with issues, you fly him out there to ride in a car in which the issues have already been fixed.

GM Delivers Just Over 1,000 New Corvettes in February 2019

GM is only reporting official sales numbers quarterly but we were able to get our hands on the Corvette sales report for February 2019 which showed just over 1,000 deliveries for the month. That's a 24% decrease in deliveries from the 1,351 sold in February 2018.

February's sales were better than the disastrous January 2019 deliveries which at 800 was the



lowest month of sales ever during the C7 generations production run.

For the calendar year to date (Jan-Feb), just over 1,800 Corvettes have been delivered.

Rumors of C8 production starting in December has people trying to backtrack the production schedule of the C7. If the December startup date holds, we think that 2019 model year production will come to a halt sometime late this summer. We can probably expect to see a plant shutdown for the model year changeover that could last a month or two before starting back up and producing C8s.

Additional signals for the looming end of the C7 will come from the dealers as certain colors and options in the next few months become constrained and/or final early buildout dates are issued.

That could be one of the reasons that Chevy isn't too concerned with the <u>inventory of the C7s nationwide</u> which has grown to 9000+ as of last month. To help dealers move remaining 2018 Corvettes, Chevy is now offering a new <u>0% APR for 72 Months</u> through April 1st.

2017 Corvette Among Several GM Models Being Recalled for Potential Power Steering Issue

Four General Motors models – including Corvette – are being recalled because of potential electric power steering failures.

Included in the recall are about 27,000 vehicles, including the <u>2017 Corvette</u>, 2017 Chevrolet Camaro, 2017 Cadillac ATS, and 2016-18 Cadillac CTS.

GM discovered the problem after opening an investigation last September



into sudden power steering losses in 2017 Camaros based on information from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.

The failures may occur while driving, making it difficult to turn the steering wheel. That could make it especially dangerous at slow speeds or around curves.

GM engineers determined that in about 80 percent of the cases involving Camaros, intermittent electrical problems occurred in the torque sensor printed circuit boards of the power steering gear assemblies. Further investigation discovered the same problems in two Corvette steering gear assemblies, and GM also found the same circuit boards being used in the two Cadillac models.

GM also noticed a spike in warranty repairs that were traced back to manufacturing errors made by Bosch, which supplied the power steering assemblies.

The failure will apparently last the whole time the car is being driven, but the steering sometimes returns once the vehicle is turned off and restarted.

Drivers are alerted to the failure by the difficult steering, obviously, as well as an instrument panel message and the sounding of a chime.

GM dealers will replace the power steering gear assemblies starting this month. For more information, call 800-222-1020 and ask about recall number N182182760.

Chevrolet is Now Offering Zero Percent Financing for 72 Months on All 2018 Corvette Models

A check of <u>Chevrolet.com's current offers</u> shows a new 0% APR financing offer for 72 months on all remaining 2018 Corvette models (Stingray/Grand Sport/Z06). Well qualified buyers must take delivery by 4/1/2019.

It's the first offer specific to Corvettes this year and we are happy to finally see some attention for dealing with the more than 9,000 new Corvettes available across the Country. However, the amount of 2018 Corvettes still



available is relatively small compared to the number of 2019s as the 2018 model year was only produced for five months with a total of 9,686 Corvette made in the shortened model year. Meanwhile, 2019

Corvette production started over 13 months ago and make up the majority of Corvettes available for sale.

We don't have any hard numbers on inventory totals by year, but just for illustration, a search of new 2019 Corvettes at Cars.com shows 5400 matches while the number of new 2018 Corvettes is only 353.

Still, it's a great offer for someone that wants a new Corvette right now, and with this being a buyers market, you should be able find a 2018 Corvette that's been <u>marked down by thousands off the MSRP</u>. As always, see your dealer for details.

GM's new Corvette is so powerful, it's warping the frame in tests, report says

The redesigned 2020 Chevrolet Corvette's new engine is so powerful that it's compromising the vehicle's structural integrity in testing, causing General Motors to delay the car's reveal, according to an industry report.

Sports car fans have been eagerly awaiting the debut of the eighth generation of the Corvette, which got its last total overhaul in the 2014 Corvette Stingray.

The 2019 Detroit auto show, which would have provided a major global stage for the vehicle's unveiling, came and went in January with no reveal.

What gives?

Well, it sounds like GM engineers are scrambling to get the vehicle ready for prime time, in part because they made it so powerful that the vehicle is bumping up against physical limitations.

A Corvette prototype with a twin-turbocharged, 8-cylinder engine generates 900 to 1,000 horsepower and caused a "structural distortion of the aluminum spaceframe" during tests.

"The twist in back was enough to fracture the glass hatch covering the engine," Hagerty reported. "Be glad this flaw was discovered in advance of your top speed runs in Chevy's designated Ferrari-beater."

At those speeds, the new "C8" sports car would be faster than the 2019 ZR1 performance model, which GM bragged is the fastest 'Vette at a top speed of 210 mph.

Other bugs, including electrical issues, are being worked out.

NCM Offering Exclusive Tours of the Corvette Assembly Plant During the NCM Bash

It's been almost two years since Corvette enthusiasts were last able to tour the <u>Bowling</u> <u>Green Assembly Plant</u> to see new Corvettes being built. The tours were shut down just before the plant underwent a three-month refurbishment that started in August 2017. So far, GM and the NCM have been vague on when tours will restart for the public but most believe that tours would resume once the C8 Corvette starts production.



The good news is that it does look like things may be progressing back to the tours restarting, at least during major events at the Museum.

An email from the NCM addressed to Lifetime and 'Spire Society' members were sent out this morning offering the unique opportunity to take a tour of the Corvette Assembly Plant during the NCM Bash on Wednesday, April 24 – Thursday, April 25th. The NCM will allow 100 VIP guests to get a sneak peek of the new plant layout as well as process improvements and efficiency changes that have been implemented. During the tour, guests will see the 7th generation Corvettes being assembled.

"We at General Motors recognize that the customer is at the center of everything we do," said Kai Spande, Plant Manager. "The culture of Chevrolet Corvette is based around the relationships we have with our customers. We truly value the many up-close, one-on-one communication opportunities we have to interact

and solicit feedback from them."

The VIP tours are 75 minutes long and will be limited to 20 guests per tour. The tours will be offered on Wednesday, April 24 at 12pm (noon), 12:30pm and 1pm CT, and on Thursday, April 25 at 9am CT. The cost to tour the Corvette Assembly Plant can be secured for a \$500 tax-deductible donation per person.



The National Corvette Museum will open the <u>Registration Page</u> for the exclusive Assembly Plant tour on Monday, March 25th at 9am CT.

"We want the loyal supporters of Corvette to be the first to see the changes at the plant. While they will see 2019 7th generation Corvettes being assembled, the experience is best for those who have toured the plant in the past, as the focus of the tour is not the build of the car but rather the improvements that have been made to the processes. These changes have secured the highest quality Corvette to-date, and we're excited to show off what we've done to improve our car for our customers," added Kai.

Hertz Will Soon Be Selling Its Fleet of 100 Special Anniversary Corvette Z06s

What was once available for rent will soon be available to buy.

Hertz has been celebrating its 100th anniversary since last August with 100 special Corvette Z06s that customers could rent at select Hertz rental locations.



Now the party is nearly over for Hertz, so you'll soon be able to buy one of these special Corvettes for your very own.

Hertz says if you want one of its special Z06s, you'd better act quickly. The company hasn't released a specific date when sales will begin but says once the cars are on the market, you'll be able to begin the Hertz flexible financing process with an online application. Hertz also suggests having your trade-in appraised early, and "then once these Corvettes are offered, you'll be well on your way to go through our No Haggle Price buying process."

The company says customers should keep an eye on the <u>Hertz website</u> to see if and when the special Corvettes will be at your nearest Hertz Car Sales location.

Appropriately enough, all 100 of the 650-horsepower Corvettes are decked out in Corvette Racing Yellow paint with dual black stripes, matching Hertz's brand colors, of course.

The cars are outfitted with eight-speed automatic transmissions, black aluminum wheels, yellow brake calipers, competition seats, and custom Hertz interior badging, including a personalized Hertz centennial anniversary plaque that displays the model number of the vehicle.

The special Z06s were offered for rent at several airport locations across the United States, including Atlanta, Boston, Chicago, Dallas, Fort Lauderdale, Fort Myers, Las Vegas, Los Angeles, Miami, New York, Orlando, San Diego, San Francisco, and Tampa.

2020 Corvette Ordering Documents Leaked Online Detail C8 Equipment, Colors, and Options

On Friday morning one of the largest leaks so far of C8 info occurred after a Corvette Forum member named

"NBVette4U" posted about how he was able to spec out a 2020 Corvette from a Canadian Chevrolet dealership which apparently had access to the C8's order details.

His post included a summary of the car that he had spec'd plus several screenshots of the GM order system that contained options and equipment info. At first, it appeared that GM might have nipped it in the bud as the thread was



locked, but by this afternoon it became apparent that the genie was out of the bottle after the documents were published.

We had those documents before noon on Friday and originally elected not to publish them for several reasons. The information you are about to see is typically what you would learn during a reveal event and from the screenshots, we can clearly see the options, colors and other equipment that was specifically designed for the C8. As a Corvette enthusiast first and foremost, I wouldn't want to be known as THE GUY to ruin the reveal of the most anticipated new Corvette for some page views. We have friends on the Corvette Team that are working so hard to bring us this car and it should be revealed on their terms.

Secondly, releasing this info gets people fired and could even cause a dealership to lose its franchise agreement. Dave Salvatore of Kerbeck Corvette posted more about this on the *Corvette Forum* and said "But if the person was taking screenshots from GM Global Connect and sharing them publicly, that's a major violation of the dealer's franchise agreement. Also, dealer's are not supposed to share any information they know that is not available to the public."

Because these documents went public, the dealer is now in a very precarious position because of a potential customer's actions. And you can bet that GM knows which dealer, sales rep, and the name of the customer involved in this leak.

But as we said, the genie is now out of the bottle and the cat is out of the bag. With the information public, we now have the obligation (and opportunity!) to jump in and discuss the information that we've heard rumored for some time but can now confirm.

The first document posted on the forum details the options and equipment that was spec'd by the customer. We saw right away that the model year was 2020 and the model listed was 1YC07 which is the same model codes for the 2020 Stingray that was spotted by US dealers a couple months ago. Along with some of the special options and colors listed, we believed right away that this information was legit. This document will be posted last as we first want to get into the details of the car with the options available.

The standard equipment is very familiar to what Corvette enthusiasts have seen over the last generation with the C7 and while there is no pricing yet released, we do see how it could be possible to reach the price targets that have been rumored to be about \$5,000-\$7,000 more than the current Stingray models today.

As has been rumored, the engine is listed as the LT2 with an 8-speed automatic dual clutch transmission that carries the M1L RPO. There are two rear axles offered, one with a 3.62 gear ratio and another with the 3.80 gear ratio. We think that one of them probably is associated with the Z51 Performance Package which is also offered on the 2020 Corvette. There are three suspension offerings that range from 4-Wheel Independent, Z51 Performance, and the Z51 Magnetic Ride Control.

Two different sets of tires are optioned so we're not sure if there will be an all-season tire offered directly from the factory or if there are different levels of the summer performance tires. Buyers will have the opportunity to select from four standard wheel designs and two optional designs. Additionally, center cap designs for the wheels include a choice of Stingray logos or a Jake logo (see below). We also see two different levels of brakes, one for the Z51 (J55) and a standard 4-wheel anti-lock option. Four different caliper colors are also shown including a new color called "Edge Red".

The next screen continues from the first and shows three full-length racing stripes in Carbon Flash, Sterling Silver, and Midnight Silver. Customers will be able to order exterior trim accents in Dark Shadow Metallic, Carbon Flash or body color. Badging will be available in both Chrome or Carbon Flash. We do see a dealer-installed option called (LPO RIK) which reads "Rear Badge, Painted Torch Red" on the summary below so it appears that at least a rear badge may be offered in different colors.

Interior trim colors include several new color options. One is called Sky Cool Gray which is most likely what we saw on the leaked interior photos from Carscoops. Two other new colors are named Morello Red and Natural. I am betting the Natural is somewhat similar to Kalahari but don't quote me on that. Also coming is a two-tone

Tension Blue combined with Twilight Blue. Tension Blue came to fame on the 2017 Collector Edition Grand Sport while Twilight Blue was included in a few design packages and featured on the 2013 60th Anniversary Edition.

The C8 Coupe will have a removable roof and the choices appear to come straight off the C7's order guide with options that include a standard body color roof (CF7) or visible carbon fiber roof panel (C2Z). There are also options for dual roof package that includes the transparent roof panel (CC3) with either the body color roof or carbon fiber roof.

Next up is a screenshot of the color choices and interior trims. The C8 will return nine current colors and add three new exterior colors to bring the color choices to 12. The new colors are named Accelerate Yellow Metallic, Rapid Blue and Zeus Bronze. Cadillac has a Zeus Bronze and while we've been told its not quite the same, the Cadillac color is a pretty brown metallic with a lot of flake to make it shine.

With the new Accelerate Yellow being available for the C8, we expect this color to also make its way onto the C8.R which will begin racing in 2020.

The interior choices show the new colors (Sky Cool Gray, Morello Red, Natural and Two-Tone Tension Blue/Twilight Blue) available in Leather or Suede trims. The Natural color also shows as "Natural Dipped" on several options. A dipped interior is usually described as everything from the windshield down is one color.

Two seats are listed as choices (which are on the 1st screenshot) and they show a Competition Sport bucket seat and a Body Contoured bucket seat called the GT2. We also note that the customer says there are six seatbelt colors offered in Black, Red, Yellow, Gray, Blue, and Tan.

And finally, here is the document that outlines the options as spec'd from the customer, and who in our opinion made some questionable color choices unless he owns a McDonald's franchise or just wants to pay homage to the C8's first public sighting which occurred at a McDonald's in Cadillac, MI. Among the options he chose were Accelerate Yellow Metallic exterior with Morello Red interior, yellow seatbelts, and GT2 seats.

From this summary we make out a number of new C8 specific options that include full video display mirrors, rear park assist, side blind spot alert and cross traffic alerts. Also coming is the rumored Adjustable Front Lift system, a 12-inch configurable color gauge cluster, and a digital audio system with a 14 Bose Audio speakers.

Returning options include the NPP Performance Exhaust, Performance Data Recorder, and Performance Traction Management (PTM).

One of the interesting dealer-installed options is a visible carbon fiber front grille insert (LPO RZ9) that we probably saw on the Nurburgring cars. This option is separate from the Front License Plate bracket (VK3) so it appears the grille insert isn't just for those owners who state requires a front license plate.

And with that, we conclude our reveal of the 2020 Corvette. It's a shame that this information has come out the way it has to the detriment of the Corvette Team, but at the same time, it does answer many of the questions that Corvette enthusiasts have had since the first sightings of the C8 Corvette.

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

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
