The Mission of The Bernie Scholarship Awards Program (BSAP) is to provide financial assistance to help offset educational and training expenses for low- and moderate- income students who live in affordable housing in Montgomery County, Maryland.

Board Adopts an Aggressive Work Program for the Year Ahead

At its September Board meeting the work program for the year ahead was adopted calling for focus on increasing annual revenues to \$60,000, integrating the Effectiveness Study with the application process and website as well as increasing the visibility of the scholarship program.

It is anticipated that the increase in revenues and visibility of the program will come from a FriendRaiser to be held shortly after the first of the calendar year. At a FriendRaiser potential donors are introduced to past recipients of scholarships who tell their story and how the scholarship has helped them achieve their academic goals.

The Board also confirmed the hiring of a part-time staff person who is charged with assisting the board in achieving the various work program:

Major Work Program Goals:

- Increase Annual Revenues to \$60,000
- Generate 35 high school seniors and 35 adult applications
- Improve the website

- Provide for a high-quality awards event that both honors the scholarship recipients and presents the program's successes and goals.

“I fully appreciate the importance of education and its effect on upward mobility and on our community and I am honored to help The Bernie Scholarship Awards Program support its mission in the community.”

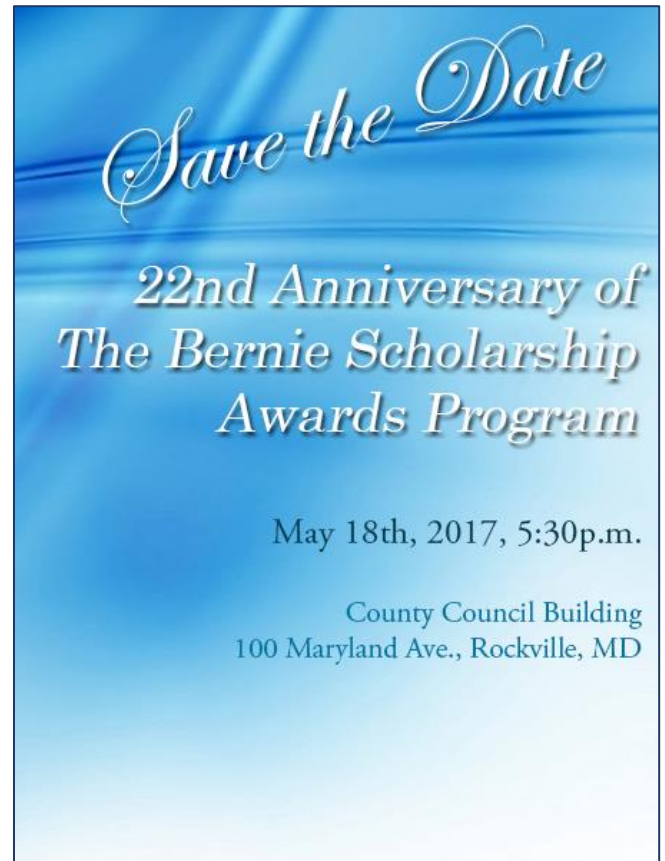
