





# ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

## GSU'S ATLANTA CAMPUS REQUIRES TEST SCORES FOR FALL 2026 ADMISSION AND LATER.

If you're applying to Georgia State's **Atlanta Campus** for Fall 2026 or later, you'll need to submit **SAT or ACT** scores along with your application. These scores, combined with your required high school curriculum GPA, are used to calculate something called your **Freshman Index (FI)** — a number used across the University System of Georgia (USG) to help determine eligibility for admission.

- Submit SAT scores at [collegeboard.com](https://collegeboard.com) using school code **5251**.
- Submit ACT scores at [act.org](https://act.org) using school code **0826**.
