AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PART OF THE ALLEY
IN BLOCK 20, TOWN OF MARBLE, COLORADO

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Marble, Colorado, has received a request from Gunnison County, Colorado, to vacate a part of the alley in Block 20, Town of Marble, Colorado; and

WHEREAS, vacation of that part of the alley will not leave any land adjoining the vacated part without an established public road connecting said land with another established public road; and

WHEREAS, vacation of that part of the alley will permit the expansion of facilities of Gunnison County to the benefit of the citizens of the Town of Marble, Colorado;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MARBLE, COLORADO:

That the following described part of the East-West alley in Block 20, between West Second Street and West First Street, Town of Marble, is hereby vacated:

a rectangle abutting Lots 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17 of Block 20, the full length of which rectangle is the eastern most one hundred twenty-five feet (125') of such alley, and the full width of which rectangle is a uniform seventeen feet (17') measured from the southern boundary of such alley, which boundary abuts such Lots 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17 of Block 20.

Subject to satisfactory assurance that the Town of Marble will receive title to the Marble City State Bank Building and its land upon completion of restoration.

FINALLY PASSED AND ADOPTED this 7th day of September, 1991.


