Spinal Motion Restriction Education	Will table producing other materials for a trauma education topic (SMR) as discussed at the Sept meeting.
Project ideas	Michael asked for any ideas for projects or products we could spend our budget money on. None identified. May purchase more triage materials.
MRSE Exercise	The NCW HERC is planning the annual Medical Response and Surge Exercise (MRSE) to occur in conjunction with the Central Wisconsin Airport triennial disaster exercise. This will be an aircraft crash associated with a weather event. EMS agencies will be requested to participate in the table-top drill in April which will stress regional resources and involve multiple smaller events occurring at the same time due to the weather event.
