## ORDINANCE NO. 980

AN Ordinance Creating the Office of City Health Officer, providing for his appointment, defining his duties, fixing his term and solary.

Be it Ordained by the Governing body of the City of Garnett, Kansas:

Section 1. That there be and hereby is created the office of City Health Officer who shall be spucinted by the governing body of said City, for the term of two years and who shall receive as a salary the sum of dollars per youth, payable monthly, such health officer shall be a regular practicing physician under the laws of the State of Kansas.

Section 2. It shall be the duty of such health officer to inspect all milk and other articles of food offered for sale or sold within the City of Garnett and to inspect and examine all premises or ploces which he shall consider necessary for the her Ith to be inspected or examined for the protection of the health of the inhabitants of said City, and to require that all #Ficles# milk or other articles of food offered for sale or sold within said City shall be pure and healthful under the ordinances of said city and the laws of the State of Kansas, and tested as provided by the ordinances of said City and State, and that all places or premises in said City shall be placed and kept in a sanitary and healthful and cleanly condition, and to require the occupant or occupants of any premises or place within said City to remove all filth, garbage, rubbish and other matter from such promises likely to produce noxious gases, odors or unhealthy conditions such as may affect the health or produce disease to any of the inhabitants of said city.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force ten days after its final passe passage and its publication in The Garnett Review.
