

**AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO
ORDINANCE O-2014-47**

**AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S PROBATIONARY APPOINTMENT
OF JAKE T. DOLD AS A PART-TIME POLICE OFFICER FOR THE AMELIA
VILLAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Amelia Village has a vacancy in its Police Department for a part-time police officer, and

WHEREAS, based on the recommendation of the Police Chief, the Mayor desires to appoint Jake T. Dold to fill the vacancy as a probationary part-time police officer;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio, that:

SECTION I. Based on the Police Chief's recommendation, the Mayor does hereby appoint Jake T. Dold to fill the vacant position as a probationary part-time police officer.

SECTION II. Village Council does hereby confirm the Mayor's probationary appointment.

SECTION III. Jake T. Dold shall serve a probationary period of six months, at such time the Mayor with the concurrence of Village Council shall remove him from the position or upon successful completion of the probationary period appoint him as a permanent part-time Amelia Village Police Officer.

SECTION IV. This appointment is contingent upon Mr. Dold passing pre-employment medical and/or psychological examinations and drug screening to ensure that Mr. Dold is physically and mentally able to perform the duties of a part-time police.

SECTION V. That Mr. Dold shall be hired as a part-time probationary police officer and his beginning salary shall be set at eleven and 50/100 dollars (\$11.50) per hour during the employee's probationary period.

SECTION VI. Pursuant to Section 701, Work Hours, of the Amelia Village Personnel Policy Manual, part-time police officers are required to work a minimum of two shifts per work period. Additional hours may be authorized by the Police Chief or the Mayor as the needs of the Village may dictate.

SECTION VII. That the position of part-time police officer shall be subject to all rules and regulations of the Village and all departmental policies and procedures as developed by the police department.

SECTION VIII. That the Amelia Village Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this council, and that all deliberations of the Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION IX. This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency which is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and general welfare. The reason for such necessity is

that the Police Department of Amelia Village has several vacant police office positions and this appointment will allow the Village to provide the necessary police protection to the citizens of the Village. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Renee moved to suspend the rules requiring three readings on three separate dates.
