Tournament News

The March 2025 El Prado Men's Club Member/Member tournament is in the books – 49 teams (98 members) participated in our usual 4 flights. Thanks to those who played. The Member/Member tournament paid out \$4558 to 28 teams (56 players). The 50/50 drawing winners were: Dave Lindsey, Troy Slavin, John Grinder - each received \$105 pot money. Ron Lovell was the free round of golf winner. Congratulations to all the winners!



We have one hiccup to report on the Chino Creek side during our Member/Member tournament. The first group out forgot to drop the tape measure off when leaving hole #4. The oversight was caught quickly, and the tape measure was brought back to the hole before most of the field played through. Here's the hiccup, and resolution: We had one member in one flight hit the green and paced off his ball and sent a video forward. His estimated distance, and that of the measured by tape distance was too close to call a winner. After board discussion it was decided to split the pot for that hole and for that flight. Since the oversight by the first group was caught early, we felt the latter was a fairer way to resolve the issue rather than disqualify the entire hole. An important reminder to all should this happen again - please leave a marker on the green! A tee, or even better a tee with a piece of paper and your name on it. Thanks everyone, and especially thank you to those members involved for understanding.

In President Cup match play – we are now in the round of 16 matches. For competitors reaching Round 16 congratulations! Members can find match results in Golf Genius under 2025 Presidents Cup Matches. If you have any issues or competition questions, please contact Doug.

April 12th is our next tournament - the ILN 5-4-3 Out. This is an individual event with plenty of forgiveness. At the end of the round, your highest net 3, 4, and 5 par scores are thrown out! So, if you triple the first 5 par, no worries! Just don't do it again. On the other hand, if you birdie the first three 5 pars, go for the eagle on the last one, as there's nothing to lose!

Look for ILN 5-4-3 Out on-line signups to open soon! Tournament signups will close Tuesday April 8th. Sign up early to guarantee a spot. Online signups will close earlier if the player limit is reached before April 8th. We will confirm the roster of signed up players in email on Wednesday April 9th before the

tournament, and release tee times and pairings by Friday April 11th.

The ILN 5-4-3 Out is an individual event, and YOU must sign up in Golf Genius yourself.

When signups open, please follow these simple steps to register:

Step 1. You will need to navigate through the signup confirmation buttons by checking Playing or Not Playing. Look, or scroll to the bottom of the invitation email and click.

Step 2. If you choose - you can also SEND message to the manager with any special request. Example – Tee time and pairing preference. (We'll try our best to accommodate)

Step 3. Hit the SEND button.

The tee sheet link in Golf Genius will populate names for the confirmed list of players. Pairings will not appear until tee times are made in Golf Genius April 19th. Registered players will get a Golf Genius automated signup confirmation email.

Helpful hint – April 12th 5-4-3 Out Tournament - AB flights will be on Chino Creek and CD flights will be on Butterfield.

Tournament and Skins News

Over the past couple of weeks, we have had some questions arise over procedures and pace of play. First, we had a situation that came up during the tournament.

The first group out accidentally failed to leave a measuring tape on the first par 3. Subsequent groups were not able to measure and were not sure what to do. Here is what you do, if this ever happens to you.

Find a piece of paper or break a small piece off the scorecard and write your name and flight on it, then stick a tee through it and leave it on the green where your ball lies. This will allow someone to measure your distance for you, when the measuring tapes are brought back to the hole.

Let's move on to pace of play.

The biggest question that is asked is simply what the proper pace of play is. Great question!



First let me say that pace of play is every member's responsibility. Failing to keep pace does not just affect you and your group; but all the groups behind you. Many players believe that if the group behind them isn't waiting, then they are good. Incorrect.

Your responsibility to keep pace with the group ahead of you has nothing to do with the group behind you.

What does it mean to keep pace?

- Keeping pace with those in front of you. This means that you will be waiting on nearly every shot, albeit for a short time.
- Keeping a pace that allows you to finish your round in less than 4 ½ hours

How to keep pace?

- Be more efficient with your time
- Play ready golf
- Watch tee shots of other golfers in your group
- Write down the score on the next tee, NOT on the green
- Complete your pre-shot routine while others are hitting/putting
- Be ready on the tee/fairway/green when it's your turn

If we all do this, the game will be much more enjoyable!

Lastly, in case you haven't seen the new Saturday flights, please look on the website and ensure you are aware of the proper flight you are in.

We play the holes together as a group, so if you've never seen 20 carts on the fairway at the same time, you won't want to miss it. And when we reach the green, we putt out closest to farthest. The highest scores on each hole earn the team an early exit, with ties broken by a chip-off. It's only a \$5 buy in, and the club sweetens the pot with an extra \$100.

We really appreciate you; we have reached the minimum amount, and our El Prado junior golf program is the sole beneficiary of this program. We have many juniors that would like to participate, and we use the funds to buy clubs and for juniors to participate in the programs. The drawing will be done live on March 21 through Instagram with a copy that will be shown in the golf shop monitors till the end of the month. Please be aware that our greens will be punched or aerified this month of March. We had to postpone the Chino Creek greens by a week due to the rains scheduled so please be patient with the quality of the greens the next few weeks. We plan on starting Chino Creek on March 17 and Butterfield Stage on March 24. The weather has been a major factor for our operations, but we are doing everything we can to minimize the inconvenience that aerification brings.

On a positive note, we continue to buy maintenance equipment. Our latest purchase is a greens cutter and roller. This purchase enables us to roll the greens on a more frequent basis and I'm sure that this improvement will be noticed immediately.



Lastly, for our rules question of the month. Please make sure to quote the exact rule that this scenario falls into. Player A declares the brand and number of his golf ball to his playing partners off the first tee and hits. He is then told by his playing partners to hit a provisional ball, Player A then hits a similar shot as his first ball. Player A then finds both his golf balls in the same area and inbounds but notices its both the same ball with no markings. How does he proceed?
