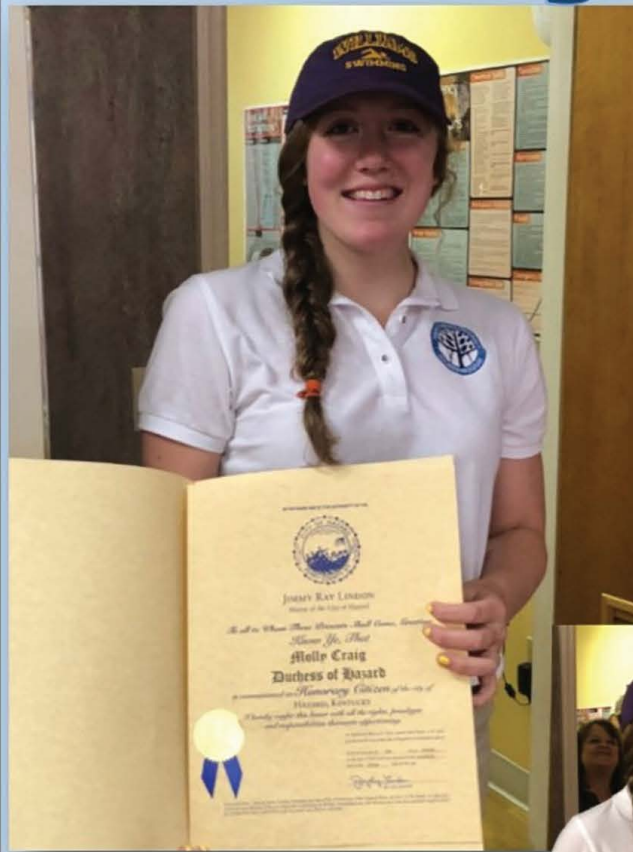

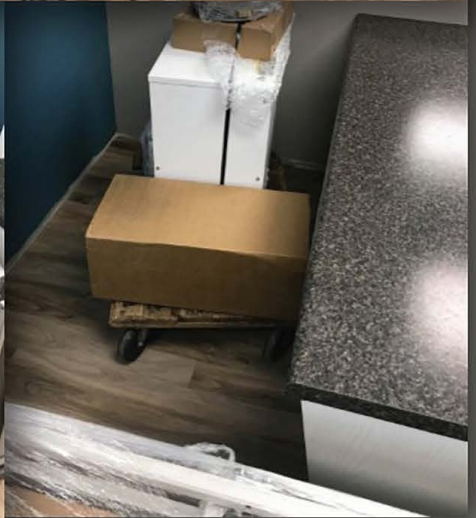

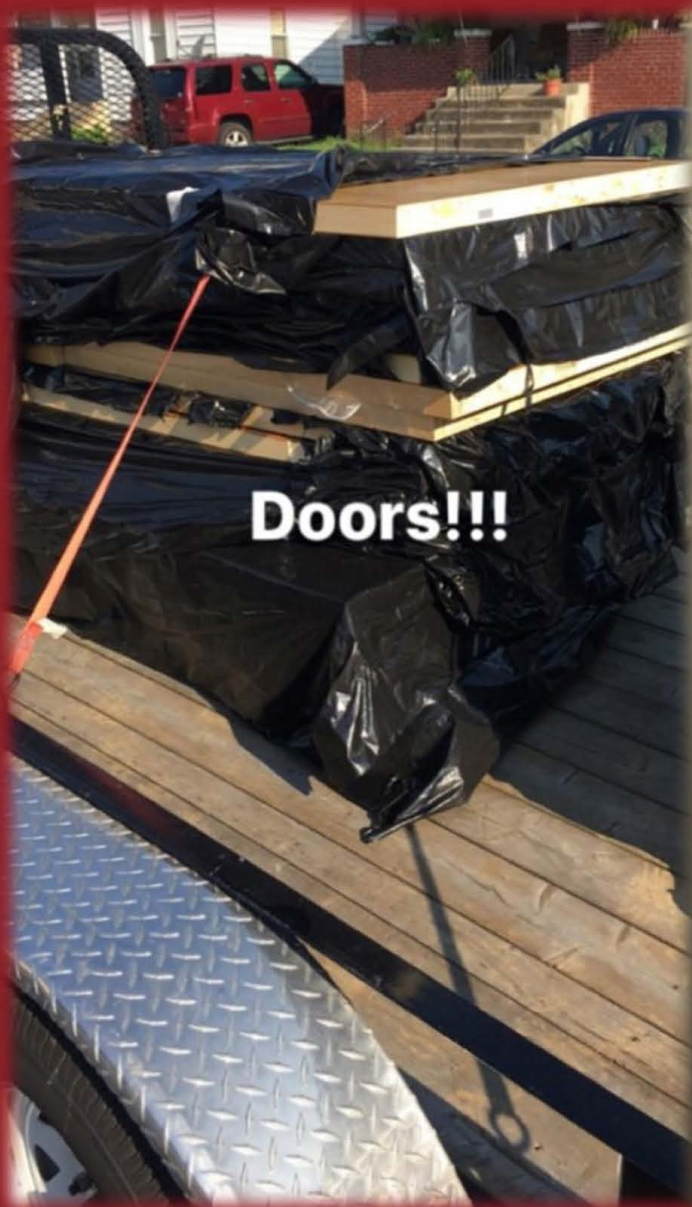

Benches (logos) will serve as proof of collaboration with our community partners.

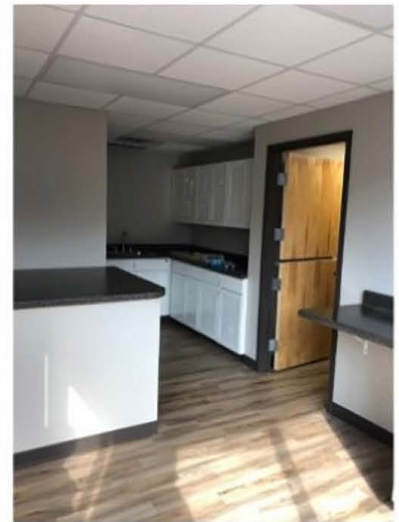
Designated bench pickup spots will help improve our transportation access and avoid potential hazardous road/driveway conditions.
