You must come prepared with the proper documentation about your specific case: DD Form 214, *and* *ALL* medical records about your disability, both military and civilian. There were over 1000 veterans who attended the last event so it is advisable for you to come early and be prepared to wait. In the past the doors opened at 8:00 AM."**
