Holy God, our righteous judge, daily your mercy surprises us with everlasting forgiveness. Strengthen our hope in you, and grant that all the peoples of the earth may find their glory in you. In Jesus' Name. Amen

First Lesson **Jeremiah 33:4-9** **4** For thus says the Lord, the God of Israel, concerning the houses of this city and the houses of the kings of Judah that were torn down to make a defense against the siege mounds and against the sword:**5** They are coming in to fight against the Chaldeans and to fill them with the dead bodies of men whom I shall strike down in my anger and my wrath, for I have hidden my face from this city because of all their evil.
6 Behold, I will bring to it health and healing, and I will heal them and reveal to them abundance of prosperity and security.**7** I will restore the fortunes of Judah and the fortunes of Israel, and rebuild them as they were at first.
8 I will cleanse them from all the guilt of their sin against me, and I will forgive all the guilt of their sin and rebellion against me.**9** And this city shall be to me a name of joy, a praise and a glory before all the nations of the earth who shall hear of all the good that I do for them. They shall fear and tremble because of all the good and all the prosperity I provide for it.

Second Lesson **1 Corinthians 12:14-26** **14** For the body does not consist of one member but of many.**15** If the foot should say, "Because I am not a hand, I do not belong to the body," that would not make it any less a part of the body.**16** And if the ear should say, "Because I am not an eye, I do not belong to the body," that would not make it any less a part of the body.
17 If the whole body were an eye, where would be the sense of hearing? If the whole body were an ear, where would be the sense of smell?
18 But as it is, God arranged the members in the body, each one of them, as he chose.**19** If all were a single member, where would the body be?
20 As it is, there are many parts, yet one body.**21** The eye cannot say to the hand, "I have no need of you," nor again the head to the feet, "I have no need of you."**22** On the contrary, the parts of the body that seem to be weaker are indispensable,**23** and on those parts of the body that we think less honorable we bestow the greater honor, and our unrepresentable parts are treated with greater modesty,**24** which our more presentable parts do not require. But God has so composed the body, giving greater honor to the part that lacked it,**25** that there may be no division in the body, but that the members may have the same care for one another.**26** If one member suffers, all suffer together; if one member is honored, all rejoice together.

Gospel **Mark 9:33-41** **33** And they came to Capernaum. And when he was in the house he asked them, "What were you discussing on the way?"
34 But they kept silent, for on the way they had argued with one another about who was the greatest.**35** And he sat down and called the twelve. And he said to them, "If anyone would be first, he must be last of all and servant of all."**36** And he took a child and put him in the midst of them, and taking

him in his arms, he said to them,³⁷ “Whoever receives one such child in my name receives me, and whoever receives me, receives not me but him who sent me.”³⁸ John said to him, “Teacher, we saw someone casting out demons in your name, and we tried to stop him, because he was not following us.”³⁹ But Jesus said, “Do not stop him, for no one who does a mighty work in my name will be able soon afterward to speak evil of me.”⁴⁰ For the one who is not against us is for us.⁴¹ For truly, I say to you, whoever gives you a cup of water to drink because you belong to Christ will by no means lose his reward.

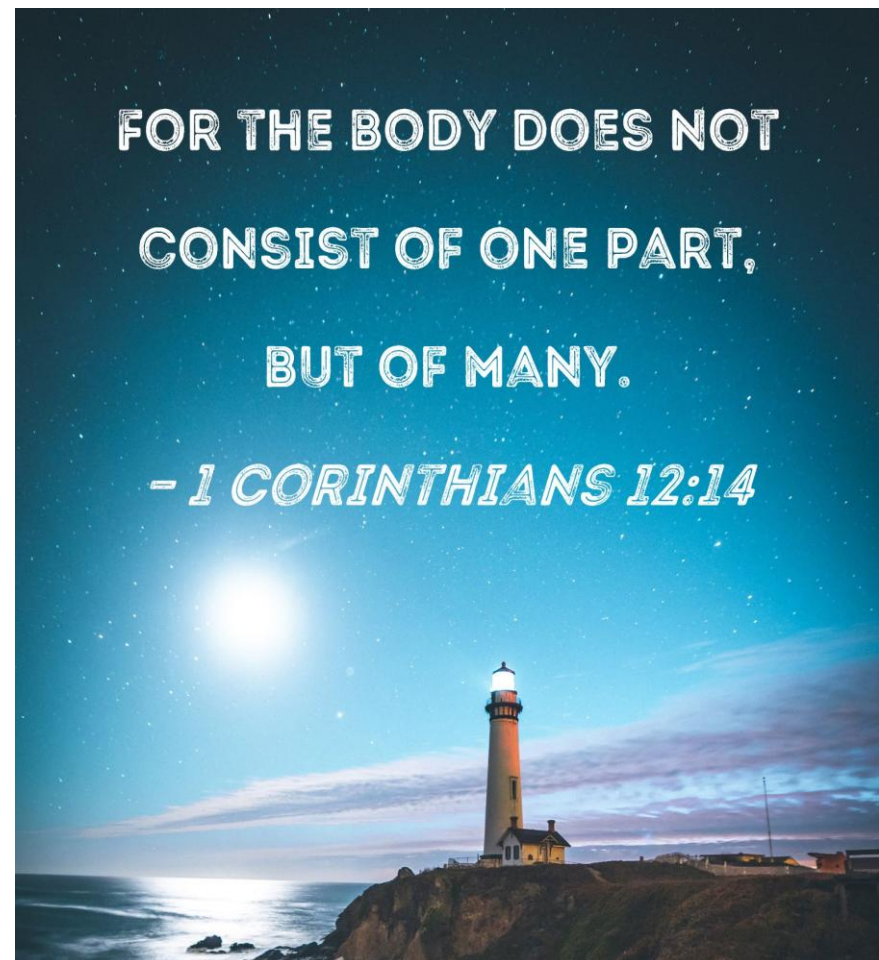
