

# **MABEL M. TOBIAS**

## **1906 - 1995**

Mabel M. Tobias, 88 of Marietta, formerly of Akron, passed away early Sunday evening, May 28, at McKenzie Memorial Hospital in Sandusky.

Mrs. Tobias was born June 3, 1906 to Mr. and Mrs. Charles Thick in Akron where she grew to womanhood and attended the public schools, later transferring to a private school near Spring Arbor. Upon completing her education she returned to Akron and married Guy Tobias in 1926. He predeceased her in 1988.
