

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE TEMPORARY RULES
OF THE
RED RIVER GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT**

Set forth below are proposed amendments to the temporary rules of the Red River Groundwater Conservation District. The proposed changes would amend District Temporary Rule 4.2(e) related to the spacing and location of new wells to extend the deadline for the District's Board to adopt hydrogeologic criteria for use by well registration applicants to no later than April 1, 2014.

Rule 4.2 Spacing and Location of New Wells.

- (e) All new non-exempt wells must provide sufficient hydrogeologic information to the District to demonstrate that the new well will not unreasonably impact exempt or non-exempt wells in the vicinity of the proposed well that are registered with the District at the time the new non-exempt well registration is administratively complete. The District's Board will adopt hydrogeologic criteria for use by well registration applicants in the implementation of this subsection no later than April 1, 2014~~2~~.
