Why get vaccinated?

Influenza ("flu") is a contagious disease that spreads around the United States every year, usually between October and May.

Flu is caused by influenza viruses, and is spread mainly by coughing, sneezing, and close contact. Wash your hands more often and cover your mouth when coughing or sneezing.

Anyone can get the flu. Flu strikes suddenly and can last several days. Symptoms vary by age, but can include: * fever * chills * sore throat * muscle aches * fatigue * cough * headache * runny or stuffy nose

Getting the Flu vaccine can :

- * Keep you from getting the flu
- * Make flu less severe if you do get it, and
- * Keep you from spreading flu to your family and other people.

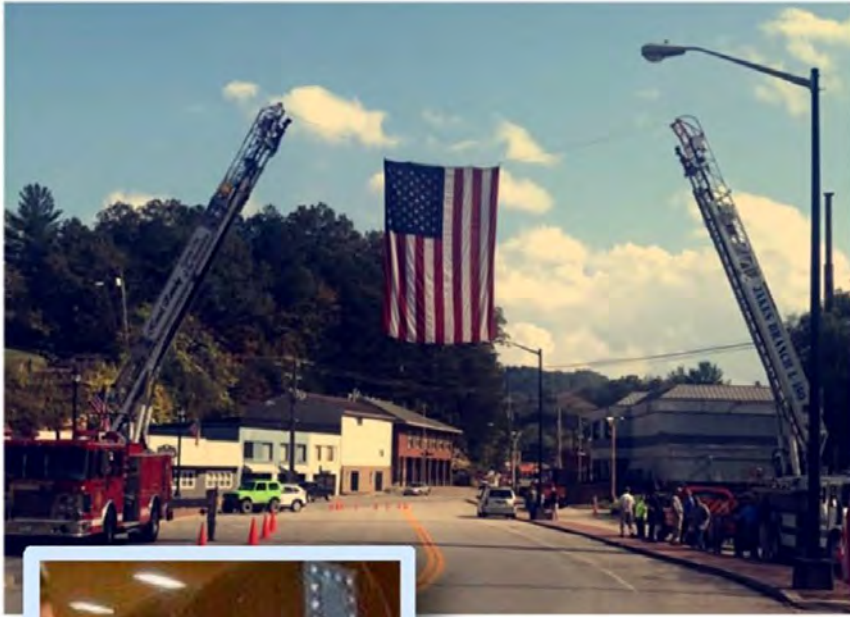

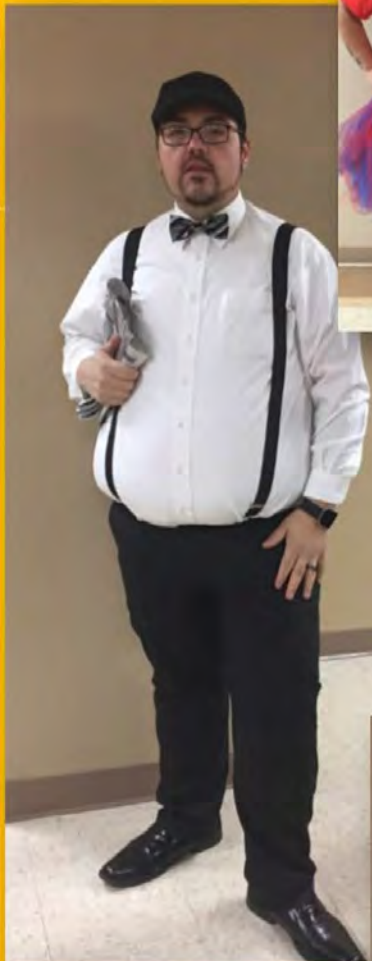

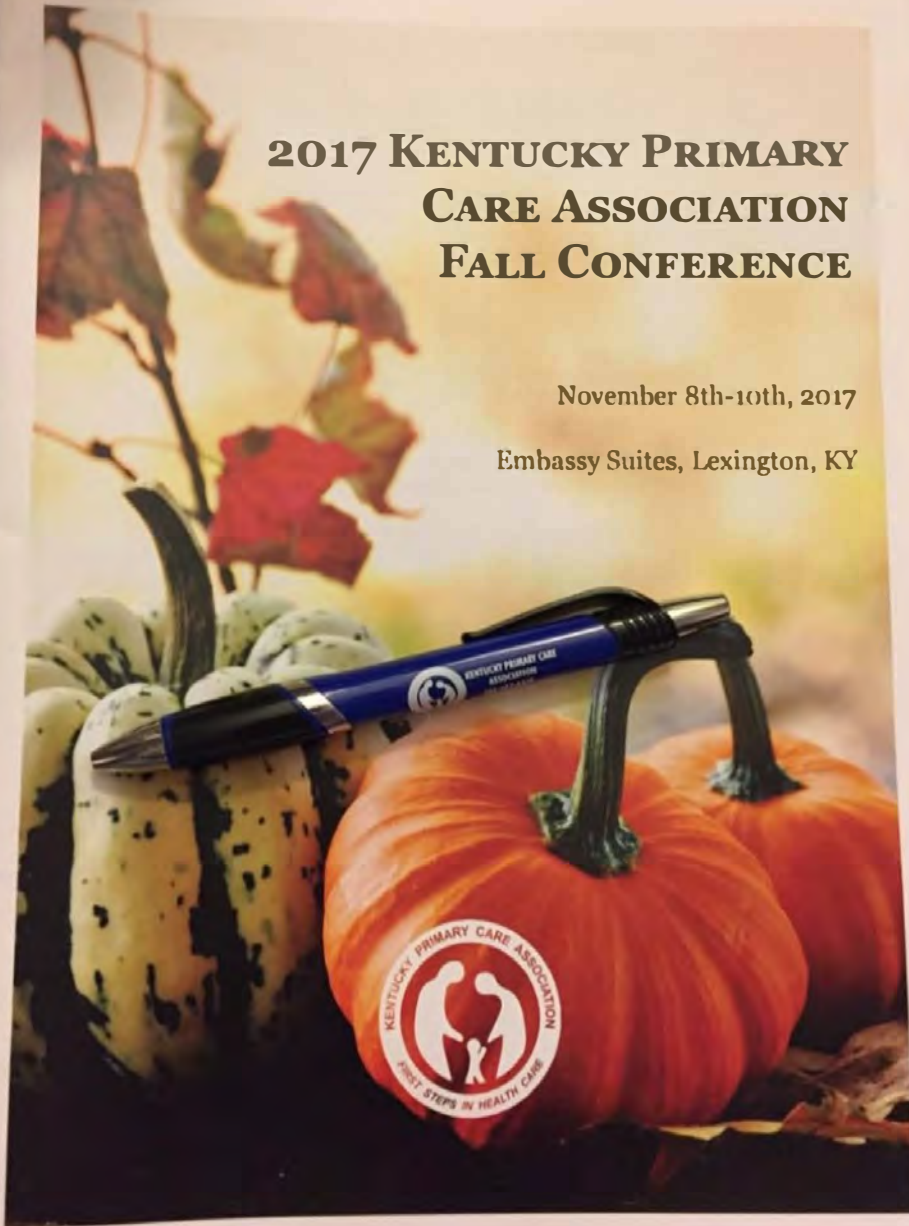
