CANONERO II, void of speed and un hurried for three-quarters, was forced to come to the extreme outside to launch his bid upon leaving the backstretch, continued to circle his field entering the stretch to take command with a bold rush in the upper stretch and was under intermittent urging to prevail. JIM FRENCH, allowed to settle in stride, moved up along the inside when launching his bid on the second turn, was forced to come out between horses entering the stretch, commenced luging into brush with BARBIZON STREAK, continued gamely to move through close quarters in midstretch, but could not reach the winner. JIM FRENCH came back with a cut on the coronet band of his right rear. BOLD REASON, badly outrun for six furlongs, moved between horses until forced to steady when blocked in the upper stretch, dropped to the inside when clear and finished with good courage. EASTERN FLEET away alertly to gain a forward position along the inside, moved through in slightly close quarters leaving the backstretch, moved to the fore between calls in the upper stretch, commenced drifting out in the closing drive and gave way willingly. UNCONSCIOUS, never far back while along the inner railing, continued to save ground while moving into serious contention on the final turn, came out for the drive and had little left when the real test came. BOLD AND ABLE was sent to the fore at once, bore out entering the first turn, came back to the inside when clear to make the pace to the top of the stretch, at which point he dropped back steadily. LIST failed to enter contention while closing some ground in the late stages. TWIST THE AXE, in hand early, moved up along the outside after three-quarters to loom boldly on the final turn, but could not sustain his bid. IMPETUOSITY, breaking smartly from his outside position, continued slightly wide to midway down the backstretch where he was dropped in to move up between horses, was forced to check sharply when JR'S ARROWHEAD dropped over at the half-mile ground, losing his action, and failed to recover when clear. BARBIZON STREAK, away in good order, was caught in close quarters entering the first turn, continued slightly wide and commenced dropping back after five furlongs. KNIGHT COUNTER was bumped and forced out entering the first turn. JR'S ARROWHEAD came away alertly to gain a striking position along the outside, commenced luging in at the half-mile ground and dropped back steadily. FOURULLA bore out badly entering the first turn. Overweight- Saigon Warrior, 1 pound.
