Treasurer's Report (Oh Snap): Checking account balance is \$4565.73. Deposits were \$6029 from Ronde and March/April raffle & shoot fees. Withdrawals were \$2954.87 website fees, ronde till, fuel, landowner fee and gift, & Ronde potties. Savings account balance is \$1625.79 with \$0.04 earned in interest. \$500 transferred to checking. Total funds balance is \$6,191.25.

2025 Ronde Review:

-Camp fees: We've set the expectation, ribbons worked well and we will use them again. -Period correct clothing was better. It was mentioned that we could look into a club "clothing closet". Gordon's photos are fantastic!

-Fort shoot went well for first year!


