## **NvFRW Pledges Unity in 2016 Election**

### ***Republican Women Will Support Republican Presidential Nominee***

Las Vegas, NV — April 28, 2016 — More than 40 Republican women leaders representing 18 clubs from the state of Nevada gathered at the Nevada Federation of Republican Women's (NvFRW) spring board meeting in Las Vegas on April 16, pledging to come together during the general election to support the 1026 Republican presidential nominee.

The NvFRW board unanimously adopted a resolution calling on members to actively support and work to elect the 2016 Republican nominee for president, as well as all Republican candidates for federal, state and local office.
