REGISTRATION

This match will be run with a traditional squad based format. Practiscore pre-registration is required to guarantee a spot; if squads are full and you did not pre-register, you will not be able to shoot the match.

\$20/shooter. SSP, ESP, REV, CDP, CCP, BUG, CO, PCC allowed. Shooting twice allowed, \$20 for second gun.

EQUIPMENT

The following equipment is required to participate:

Firearm: A properly working pistol or revolver, 9mm/.38 caliber or larger.

Holster: A strong side holster that covers the entire trigger guard, no pocket, shoulder, appendix, or cross draw permitted.

Magazines: At least 2 spare magazines. A method of carry such as a belt mounted double magazine is recommended, but pockets may be used for magazines.

Ammunition: At least 150 rounds of ammunition.

Concealment Garment: Clothing must be worn so that all shooting equipment is not visible with your arms extended to your sides, parallel to the ground.
