

A SUDDENLY WORD

I apologize for not writing sooner, but the Lord has had me keep silent for some time for a reason. This past spring He gave me a word that became a book. He has been sharing this book with me for almost 42 years. As a new Christian I didn't understand exactly what He was saying. Over time, it became clear He was speaking to me about what we in Christianity call the end times, and more particularly, the last end-time harvest revival or ingathering of souls. For now, let me share a few words He gave me before all of this starts. The enemy of our souls is trying to prevent an end-time harvest revival. He would much rather the saints get raptured out and millions upon millions of souls go to hell instead of get saved, set free and delivered. We must understand that an end-time revival is part of betrothal promises our Lord made us, just as He did with Israel in Exodus 19:5-8.¹ We must be adamant to receive nothing less than what Jesus promised us before we go up with Him. If you would have asked me five years ago whether the pieces were in place for the rapture of the bride, the

tribulation or the anti-christ I would have said not exactly. That is no longer the case.

Please understand that this whole nightmare concerning a pandemic is nothing more than an attempt to inject millions with technology to change the DNA of the human race. I've written about this before so I'm not including a footnote. You can review my last article and you can pick up a copy of the new book. I can share the immediacy of what I think will happen.

First, I believe it will begin with the death of the president— or at least the individual we know to be sitting behind the desk in the present White House. It will come suddenly. Next, things will become of such a state that those of us who know Jesus must pray for Him to come and rescue us as a kinsman redeemer would have done. I write that because it will become very obvious that we, as American citizens have been sold for nothing. Our present, lying, news media will have no recourse but to finally tell the truth. "Sold for nothing" were the exact words I heard the Father say. I have good news. Once we cry out as both citizens and saints, God will arise. The scripture He gave me was from Psalm 68:1-9:

"Let God arise, let his enemies be scattered: let them also that hate him flee before him. As smoke is driven away, so drive them away: as wax melteth before the fire, so let the wicked perish at the presence of God. But let the righteous be glad; let

them rejoice before God: yea, let them exceedingly rejoice. Sing unto God, sing praises to his name: extol him that rideth upon the heavens by his name JAH, and rejoice before him. A father of the fatherless, and a judge of the widows, is God in his holy habitation. God setteth the solitary in families: he bringeth out those which are bound with chains: but the rebellious dwell in a dry land. O God, when thou wentest forth before thy people, when thou didst march through the wilderness; Selah: The earth shook, the heavens also dropped at the presence of God: even Sinai itself was moved at the presence of God, the God of Israel. Thou, O God, didst send a plentiful rain, whereby thou didst confirm thine inheritance, when it was weary.”

Psalm 68:10-18: “Thy congregation hath dwelt therein. Thou, O God, hast prepared of thy goodness for the poor. The Lord gave the word: great was the company of those that published it. Kings of armies did flee apace: and she that tarried at home divided the spoil. Though ye have lien among the pots, yet shall ye be as the wings of a dove covered with silver, and her feathers with yellow gold. When the Almighty scattered kings in it, it was white as snow in Salmon. The hill of God is as the hill of Bashan; an high hill as the hill of Bashan. Why leap ye, ye high hills? This is the hill which God desireth to dwell in; yea, the LORD will dwell in it for ever. The chariots of God are 20,000, even thousands of angels: the Lord is among them, as in Sinai, in the holy place. Thou hast ascended on high, thou hast led captivity captive: thou hast received gifts for men; yea, for the rebellious also, that the LORD God might dwell among them.”

The psalm continues on and speaks many truths for this period of time that are both illuminating and sobering. But it ends with these two verses: “Ascribe ye strength unto God: his excellency is over Israel, and his strength is in the clouds. O God, thou art terrible out of thy holy places: the God of Israel is he that giveth strength and power unto his people. Blessed be God” (Psalm 68:34-35).

Once these events proceed and pass, we will suddenly be in revival. I know that there are a few saints already in it. I could say they are in the beginning stages. I’ve experienced so many revivals that I have lost count. I did not seek them out. The Lord Himself put us in them. This last revival will be an ingathering that will last for approximately thirty to forty years, depending upon when Father says enough is enough. During that period of time I am convinced the bride will be caught up. Those left on the earth, that have not accepted Jesus Christ, will need the comfort and strength that this new book I have written can provide. It is not just for them, but it is a NOW word for the church as well.

Let me share an extension, or lesson from one of the things He showed me as I was writing it. Back in early spring, we were singing a song in church that had the words “Suddenly” in it. As I started singing, the glory of God descended upon me. I started to laugh and cry. If it were not for the fact that I was already seated, I’m not sure I could have stood. The next morning, Monday, He gave me the book and its title. He said now is the time to write what He had been showing me about this period of events. I finished the book within three weeks. For those of you

who know me, you know that's a quick work. It took much longer to publish for several reasons. One of them was the fact that Bill had his surgery and I was recovering from my accident.

I also decided to have the ministry go into publishing. That's because the Lord gave me no other options except to become a truly independent author. Usually I look for a reasonably priced publishing house. Unfortunately, those options don't seem available any longer. As I was finishing up the last edit, I looked over a concept that was highlighted to me by Father. As I kept studying the words on the page I realized He was giving me this article. Here is an excerpt from one of the last concepts this long-term ingathering will unveil. It is found under the subheading:



“Love Builds A Home”:

“The Ephesian church was watching, like we are today, for that call up to our marriage feast. “A home always has an atmosphere. Many men don’t realize this when they marry. The Bible tells men not to marry a contentious woman as it will affect their lives forever (Proverbs 21:19; 27:15-16). Women also have heartache if they marry a fool for a husband. Abigail knew that when she went to save her husband, Nabal (1 Samuel 25:2-38). She told David quite plainly: “Let not my lord, I pray thee, regard this man of Belial, even Nabal: for as his name is, so is he; Nabal is his name, and folly is with him: but I thine handmaid saw not the young men of my lord, whom thou didst send” (1 Samuel 25:25). We get the impression from the passage that she was always mopping up after him.”

“That’s when it dawned on me. What if a marriage in wholeness maintained the habitat where Adam and Eve lived? We know the overriding presence of God made that anointing possible. Yet, something changed the whole planet when Adam and Eve’s covenant was broken with God. It also disrupted their covenant with one another. We know from Genesis the resultant chaos changed the water flow and the tree of life had to be cut off to them. They were kicked out of their home.”³

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I thought it so odd that this Garden we call Eden was their home. As I meditated on that fact, I realized we do some things in our gardens that keep us and those around us alive. Let me share some quick thoughts I had. These concepts or survival skills will keep our nation thriving. As many of you know, the previous

book I wrote, “70 Years of American Captivity: The Polity of God, The Birth of a Nation and The Betrayal of Government”⁴ was a warning from our Lord. It is not a prophecy, unless we refuse to listen. God is not judging America. Unfortunately, we are doing this to ourselves by breaking our American covenant.

The “70 Years of American Captivity” book documents covenant and the specific governmental covenant we, as American citizens have with one another, our government—and for those who believe—our God. Covenant is what will keep this nation humming along. We have broken that covenant with one another. Once we come back to our senses, and come back in line with covenant again, the skills we use to maintain a garden are the same skills we can use to maintain covenant and thus maintain the nation.

Adam and Eve’s home was a garden; but today our homes are not gardens. Let me ask the question: What is a garden?

~Number one, it is Sustenance. It is what we grow to feed bodies.

~Number two, it is Sacrifice for others as well as yourself. You learn what it takes to work and feed yourself and others.

~Three, it is Provision. You must think beyond your present ‘box’ and think for “now” and for the future.

~Fourth, it is Respect for God's creation. You learn it is sacrifice for you and for what you harvest. You learn how it was made.

~This produces the fifth item: Awe for God's handiwork. You learn His awesome ability to create; and, in that place, you learn a deep reverence for who He is.

~The sixth item I would place in this list is what I call a Convergence of Need. Convergence because it's where you realize you need to ask God how to do what the plants and people need. So you must ask, and in asking, the place becomes a convergence where God shows up to meet all the needs of you, the people you feed and the plants and animals in the garden.

~Lastly, or item number seven, you learn how to protect the plants from themselves and from outside intruders. If you do not learn this critical last concept, you will never have a garden or sustenance or anything else on this list. I postulate that our unique American governmental covenant is a garden. These lessons easily translate to a home, a marriage and to a country. But I'd like to have us focus on maintaining our covenant.

The other day I was talking to the Lord and asking Him how He could possibly love the human race. I was going on and on about how gross and disgusting we are physically and how spiritually bereft we are as a creation. I was rather clear that animals have more compassion than what humans display from their souls to their fellow mankind. The Holy Spirit was quite clear to me. He said He had not created Adam the way we see each other now. In fact, He was quite clear that I see mankind from the place of our

fallen natures. God created Adam in such a way that he was magnificent.

Not long thereafter, I had the opportunity to look up into the night sky. It happened to be one of those cloudless evenings. The depth of the blue was awesome. Up above, the stars were stunning. As my eye went to the horizon there was a gorgeous purple-blue meeting in the sky. I thanked the Lord for how fantastic He had made this planet for us to live on. That's when He said, "If you think this is fantastic, you should have seen how I made Adam."

This is how He speaks to me when He is trying to get a concept across. He will wait for a period of time and then get His reality through to me. This was it: If I think His creation is awesome, His truth is that Adam was more magnificent. If I will realize this, I need to understand that Jesus wants us to know how awesome He has made us. Those of us who have gone through the second birth have been redeemed to a place of sovereignty where we can declare the word of the Lord and receive by grace all Jesus has promised us.

We can see souls set free, whole countries delivered from communism and the "great reset." We can see signs and wonders accompany the preaching of the gospel. As we share Jesus with people, we should ask if they need to be healed. We can see Jesus heal them NOW, TODAY. This will set America free. As this truth is realized by saints in many countries, it will set millions of souls free across the entire planet.

I pray we learn these concepts now, rather than later. If we procrastinate, it is possible that later may come too late for some folks. Let's believe, receive and do exactly what Jesus tells us to do. When we do that, we will be like the servants at the wedding in Cana of Galilee. The river of revival we have been promised will turn into the new wine the Holy Spirit gives. Whole neighborhoods will be set free. Neighborhoods become regions and regions become countries and countries flow all over the Earth. At that point saints, look up, for your redemption draws nigh. It's very probable the Bride will go up and the wedding feast will begin. Even so, Come, Lord Jesus, Come!
