

# BNC Phoenix Presents Our Fall Event

Friday, October 11th - 10:00 am

Our Fall Event features Josh Trachtenberg, Neuroscientist and Professor of Neurobiology at UCLA as our speaker.

Dr. Trachtenberg, a Brandeis alum, is a leader in studying the living brain in action using advanced imaging technology. After establishing his research laboratory at UCLA, he founded a company – Neurolabware – in order to build the sophisticated custom research microscopes that are needed to help understand how the brain develops and how diseases and injuries interrupt its normal functioning. Dr. Trachtenberg will discuss how the new Brandeis microscope is a game-changer in the field of neuroscience.

Just about everyone has been touched by neurodegenerative diseases. This past year, our chapter worked to support the Magnify the Mind Initiative. Thanks to your generosity, we met our goal and Brandeis University is now in the process of obtaining a two-photon microscope, which can be reconfigured as techniques evolve.






Bill Colter was born and raised in Detroit, Michigan. He served as an enlisted US Marine for three years before attending and graduating from college with degrees in Political Science and History.


