Confirmation Tasks of Faith

FOUR of these tasks must be completed by May 1st

- 1) Create an art project expressing your faith (must be pre-approved)
- 2) Teach a Sunday School class
- 3) Complete 3 Sermon Notes
- 4) Attend a Session or Committee Meeting
- 5) Complete a Service Project outside of Church, or School
 - Cannot be a Service Project used for any other clubs or school events
- 6) Interview Opportunities Questions must be pre-approved, with notes taken or recorded during the interview.
 - o a Parent, Grandparent or Mentor about their faith and life in the church
 - a Classmate of another faith
 - A Deacon or Elder of your Presbyterian Church
- 7) Sign up to be a part of Worship Sunday Mornings
 - Present Special Music, offer to be a Lay Reader, or Usher
- 8) Plan, organize and lead a youth event (Sledding, Movie Night, etc.)
- 9) Support, or help out with a Church Project
- 10) Write a 1,000 word essay on the Reformata Ecclessia, or the 2nd Reformation Scottish Covenantors.

Confirmands must complete four Tasks of Faith, as well as a Faith Statement and Interview, as stated below, by May to be Confirmed.

Students will be putting together a 5 point faith statement:

- 1) What do you believe about God?
- 2) What do you believe about Jesus?
- 3) What do you believe about the Holy Spirit?
- 4) What do you think the purpose of the Church is?
- 5) Presbyterians believe strongly in vocational calling. We each have a purpose, and a call, to make our world a better place, whether by delivering pizzas, or as President of the USA, we are to shine where we find ourselves!
 - a. What are your gifts and talents and how will they use them in the Church?
 - b. How or what do you feel God is calling you to be a part of in life or with your Presbyterian Church?
