



Governing Body members present: Mayor, Mark Goodenow; Councilmembers, Mark Jack, Jim Smith, Waide Purvis, Jeff Rosell and Ashley Rice.

City Staff present: Maintenance Supervisor, Robert Krohn and City Clerk, Vicki Zentner.

There being a quorum present, Mayor Goodenow called the special meeting to order after which the tour of the previously listed city properties was had.

Upon the conclusion of the tour, the Governing Body reconvened at the Community Center to hold a goal setting work session.

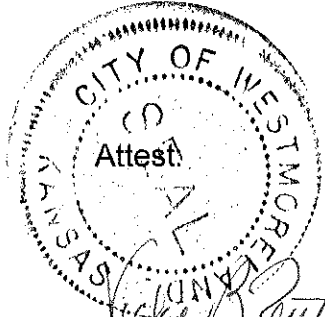
Goals set in no particular order were:


- Repairing/replacing fence along the 1st base and 3rd base sides at the ball diamond
- Looking at LED lighting for the ball diamond to replace existing lights
- Lighting at the tennis court in City Park-perhaps LED on a timer
- Restroom at city Park
- Cabin at the RV Park
- Uses for the old track west of the ball diamond
- More housing development
- Cleaning up of dilapidated housing and buildings
- Putting in sidewalk from the county fleet building to the city shop and then to the RV Park
- Sidewalks in the new addition as well as possibly on Campbell Street

There being no further goals mentioned, Councilmember Rosell moved to adjourn the goal setting meeting. Councilmember Jack seconded the motion. The motion passed five (5) ayes to zero (0) nays.

Mayor Goodenow declared the goal setting meeting adjourned at 7:50 PM.
