7. **July Show**: Rich M. indicated the July 29th car show is ON.

The Show committee allocated duties and responsibilities to handle the workload. Billy S. is chairperson; Tony M. is responsible for vendors, and Dennis P. is handling emails etc. **A job list was handed out.**

Billy indicated that NEW to this car show is that we will collect a suggested donation of 2 dollars per spectator (children under 12 free). Billy asked for a volunteer to prepare a sign stating "Suggested Donation 2 dollars", and a bucket that will collect the 2 dollar donation. Nick C. volunteered.

Two members will be assigned as "entrance guards" on an hourly basis to sit at the table to collect donations. (This table has the Donation Sign and "Bucket").

The show committee went to the location to answer member questions. Think of the area as a football field. The entrance to the event will have police barriers set up. At the opposite end of the near the "gazeboes" will be the where vendors and electricity are located. Andy G. will provide electric cables for the event. The

DJ will be around the 40-yard mark. Members will park their cars separating the spectator parking from the event participants.

Billy asked that everyone get to the event Sunday morning by 7 am. Since we are not meeting on Saturday “goodie” bags will be prepared Sunday morning. We need members to fill the “goodie bags”.

The show officially starts at 9 am but people come early.
Rich Morgante has taken care of bathrooms.

Billy S. indicated that Dennis P. who is handling emails would send out one this week, next week and two days before the event.

There is NO shade for members; spectators have the gazebo to stay out of the sun and eat their food. We need tents, chairs, folding tables; a minimum of five (5) tables. If you have these items, contact Billy if you need a way to get them to the event.

Member cars will not be on the entrance road but at the parking lot. Signs directing people will be set up. The event is near the tennis courts.

Trophies will be ordered.

The PBA ordered the “Pizza Truck” to the event. The PBA has asked to meet with the committee next week.

John K. led a round of applause for the show committee.

Tony M. reported on the status of vendors:

We have three food vendors;

“Looney Tunes” will be serving breakfast at 9 am. Lunch – Chicken, dirty water dogs etc.

Billy S. emphasized that volunteers are needed and to everyone should sign up. Larry Sachs asked to be a judge. Billy indicated that Judging will be similar to

our May show. It will have 5 categories – numbered 1 to 10. People will be in team with a novice judge and experienced judge.

Before judge starts Billy S. will conduct a mock judging of a car.

John K. reminded that the club will abide with the rules of Downing park for the picnic.

Nick C. asked about Carlisle. It was tabled until the next meeting.

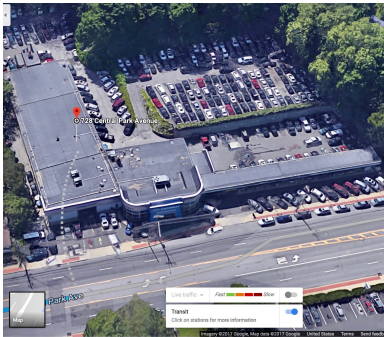
