

POLICY ON SCHOOL CLOSINGS**POLICY**

Once the school calendar has been officially adopted by the Board of Education, the responsibility for all deviations from the calendar for reasons of acute storms, plant failures, extraordinary staff projects, etc., rests with the Superintendent of Schools.

It is the policy of the Board of Education to have the schools in operation full-time, every day provided for in the calendar. However, if there is a good reason to shorten a school day or not to open school on a particular day, that decision will be made and communicated within the limits of available facilities by the Superintendent of Schools.
