SAME CLASSES FOR DOGS AND BITCHES

Winners from these classes will compete for Best of Breed

Veteran Dogs & Bitches - 7 yrs. & Older

At Independent Specialties Neutered dogs and Spayed bitches may compete.

Field Trial Classes

For dogs & bitches that have a 1st through 4th placement in an AKC Field Trial and/or have earned one of the AKC Hunt Test Titles (JH, SH, MH)

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes, will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Stud Dog Class - \$24.00 For Stud Dogs and two or more of their Get, which are also entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the get. The owner of the stud dog need not be the owner of the get. The Stud Dog must appear in the ring with his get and be entered in the Stud Dog Class. Stud Dogs do not need to be entered in another class.

Brood Bitch Class - Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Brace Class - For two dogs or bitches both with at least one common owner. Brace must be marked as an Additional Class. Entry fee is for the unit.

\$24.00 if BOTH dogs are entered in the show.

\$30.00 if BOTH dogs are **NOT** entered in the show.

NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The ISCC will hold **NOHS** events at both Specialties.

Please check the box on your dog's entry form if you are eligible and wish to enter this special **Owner-Handled Best of Breed** competition.

Online entrants – Please check the Owner Handler Eligible box, or write '**NOHS**' in the Additional Classes box.

Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

\$20.00 – Additional or Individual Entry

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 18 years of age on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 First Place wins in an Open class, with competition, to be eligible to enter the AKC National Championship competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry on the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE

ALL JUNIOR HANDLERS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE AN AKC NUMBER PRIOR TO THE DAY OF THE EVENT. Numbers may be obtained from the American Kennel Club, call (919) 816-3776. Junior handlers must put their nine-digit number on the entry blank. Be sure to include all information required on both the front and back of the official AKC entry form.

PUPPY & VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

The Puppy Sweepstakes is open to Irish Setters 6 months and under 18 months of age on the day of the show. All Puppy/Junior sweepstakes entries **MUST** be entered in one of the Regular classes at this show.

The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Irish Setters (7) seven years of age and older on the day of the show. Veterans in Sweepstakes do not need to be entered in any other class at the show.

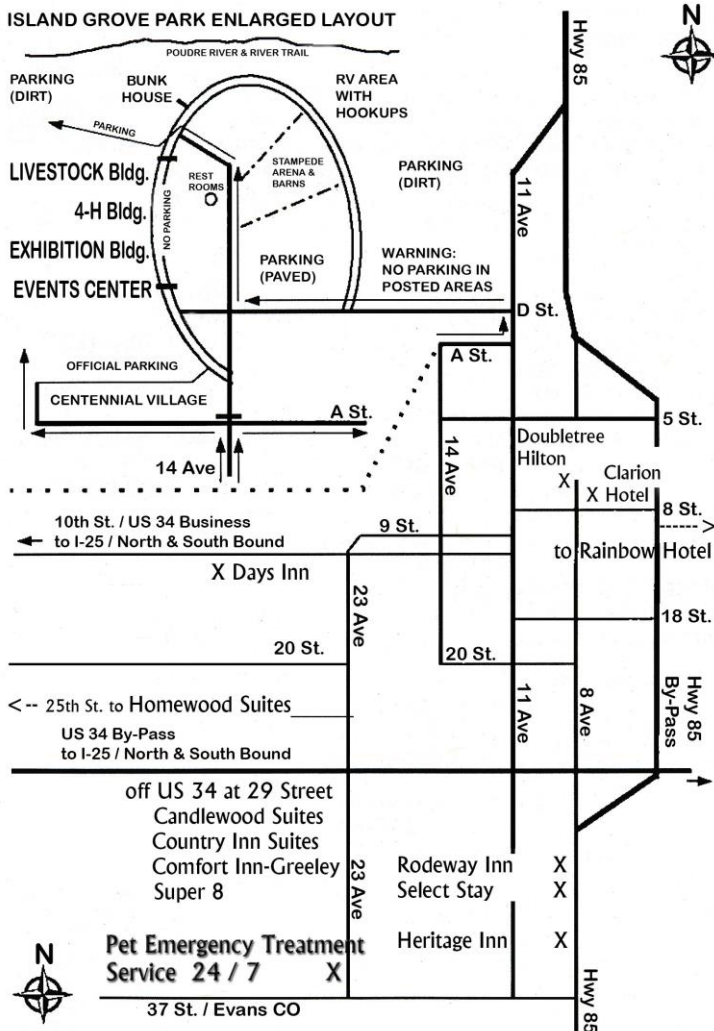

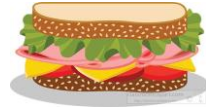

ISCA VERSATILITY TEST

From the Irish Setter Club of America VC Program rules -

GUIDELINES FOR CONFORMATION VERSATILITY JUDGING (VC only)

Versatility Conformation judging should be based on the present Standard which emphasizes the make and fit of all the parts and over-all balance. You are not attempting to determine whether the dog is of championship caliber in conformation but whether the specimen reflects the qualities of a pure-bred Irish Setter. A Versatility Pass should be withheld only if you would withhold a ribbon at a regular AKC Breed Show. Dogs will be presented in a condition that will allow for the adequate evaluation of coat, color, structure and movement. Three (3) passes under three (3) different judges are required.

The judging will be guided by the following scale of points:

- 20 - Head
- 20 - Body
- 30 - Running Gear
- 5 - Coat
- 25 - Size, Temperament, and General Appearance

I.S.C.A. Versatility Certificate Conformation Tests

(Offered on both days after Sweepstakes, but before AKC Conformation judging begins.)

\$8.00 per test per dog

V.C. Tests for Conformation are offered in accordance with the **Irish Setter Club of America's Versatility Certificate** requirements. Dogs participating in the VC Test **NEED NOT** be entered in any other class at the ISCC Specialty. Dogs must be 6 months of age or older to enter. ILP registered dogs may enter VC Tests.

Entries must be made on a separate entry form (use the form below or an official AKC entry form is acceptable) and must be clearly marked with the words "Versatility Test." A ribbon signifying PASS shall be awarded to those dogs who participate in and pass this test.

The Irish Setter Club of Colorado, The Greeley KC, and their Show

Secretary/Superintendent(s) assume no responsibility for a wrong entry. Entries will not be accepted without proper fees and signatures. Entries must be submitted on approved entry forms with the agreement printed on the reverse side. Photocopies of front & back will be accepted if legible. Exhibitors are advised to print all unusual words when filling in entry forms.

THIS SHOW is governed by the American Kennel Club. Exhibitors should read the AKC agreement on the backside of the entry form in this Premium List.

No entry fee will be refunded for Bitches who come in season after the close of entries for this show, or for a dog that is absent, sick, lame, disqualified or excused by Veterinarian, Judge or Bench Show Committee. No entry fees will be returned if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, strikes or any other causes beyond the control of the management. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The wellbeing of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made. **Note: Exhibitors** should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

RETURNED CHECKS will be charged a \$30.00 collection fee. The returned check and fee must be paid with Cash at the Show Secretary's desk or office **BEFORE** the dog will be allowed in the ring.

Dogs need not be at the show until the scheduled time of judging. Dogs no longer needed for further judging will be excused. This show is unbenched.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

The Clubs, Island Grove Regional Park, Show Secretary/Superintendent, their Agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for injury to children or pets not under the control of their parents, handlers, owners or guardians.

THIS IS A SELF-CLEANING SHOW. A Bench Show Committee will be called on anyone not cleaning up after their dog or their grooming space and a minimum of \$250.00 fine will be assessed.

Class cash prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging is over, and the Show Secretary's office advised at once. The Show Secretary and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging is over.

RECORDING & EVENT FEES include the 50¢ AKC Recording Fee and the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on the first entry of a dog and a \$3.50 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single-entry classes. There is no recording fee or event service fee for sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions. (AKC Rule, Ch 11, Sec 2).

TRANSFERS TO BEST OF BREED must be made at the Show Secretary's desk at least one-half hour prior to the start of the earliest conformation judging at each Show.
