Students will participate in a one week legal institute, during which time they will attend an abridged law school session, and a two week internship consisting of shadowing at area law offices and courts. Students who complete the program will receive a \$250 stipend.

The program will be held from June 9 through June 27, 2014 at the Louisiana Bar Center in New Orleans.

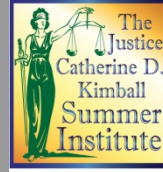
