

## Recycle...It's Easy

It is not necessary to sort your recyclables into separate receptacles for curbside pickup.

## ACCEPTED

Corrugated cardboard Newspaper Magazines Chipboard (cereal boxes) Plastic Grocery or Trash Bags Clean Aluminum Foil and trays (minus any trash) Dry Cleaning Bags Bubble Wrap Glass Bottles & Jars Aluminum Cans Phone Books

Junk Mail & Office Papers (shredded paper is to be bagged in a clear plastic bag) Plastic Bottles, jugs and tubs (caps on bottles & jugs are permitted) Tin or Steel Cans (aerosol cans are permitted if the contents have been completely removed)

## WE DO NOT ACCEPT

- Any Municipal Solid Waste Gift Wrap Any Hazardous Items Yard Waste Electronics Books Heavily Dyed or Neon Colored Paper Styrofoam **Plastic Silverware** Food Bags (ex. Potato chip bags, frozen food bags) Flexible Packaging Mirror Glass Cups and Lids Misc Steel pieces (including coat hangers) Wood Aseptic Containers (ex. juice boxes)
- Tapes & CD's Tyvek or Nylon Envelopes Tissue Paper or Paper Towels Diapers Wax Paper Photographs Foil Paper Paper Plates Straws Cereal Bags Window Glass Shower Curtains Piping Appliances Wax Cartons (ex. milk, ice cream)

Recycling is picked up on the 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Fridays of every month. It is completely on a voluntary basis. You decide if you want to recycle. If you choose to recycle, you must provide your own container for your recycling products.
