It is not necessary to sort your recyclables into separate receptacles for curbside pickup.

ACCEPTED

Corrugated cardboard	Dry Cleaning Bags
Newspaper	Bubble Wrap
Magazines	Glass Bottles & Jars
Chipboard (cereal boxes)	Aluminum Cans
Plastic Grocery or Trash Bags	Phone Books
Clean Aluminum Foil and trays (minus any trash)	
Junk Mail & Office Papers (shredded paper is to be bagged in a clear plastic bag)	
Plastic Bottles, jugs and tubs (caps on bottles & jugs are permitted)	
Tin or Steel Cans (aerosol cans are permitted if the contents have been completely removed)	

WE DO NOT ACCEPT

Gift Wrap	Tyvek or Nylon Envelopes
Any Hazardous Items	Tissue Paper or Paper Towels
Yard Waste	Diapers
Electronics	Wax Paper
Books	Photographs
Heavily Dyed or Neon Colored Paper	Foil Paper
Styrofoam	Paper Plates
Plastic Silverware	Straws
Food Bags (ex. Potato chip bags, frozen food bags)	Cereal Bags
Flexible Packaging	Window Glass
Mirror Glass	Shower Curtains
Cups and Lids	Piping
Misc Steel pieces (including coat hangers)	Appliances
Wood	Wax Cartons (ex. milk, ice cream)
Aseptic Containers (ex. juice boxes)	

Recycling is picked up on the 1st & 3rd Fridays of every month. It is completely on a voluntary basis. You decide if you want to recycle. If you choose to recycle, you must provide your own container for your recycling products.
