Planning a trip to Disney in the next year? You won't want to miss this interesting and informative session with Disney expert and local travel agent Jocelyn Martins.

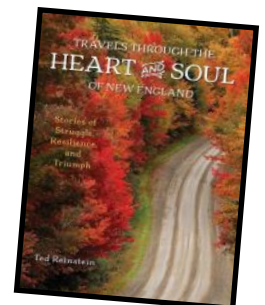
She will share some of her tips and tricks for getting the most out of your trip. You might even win a Disney goodie basket door prize!

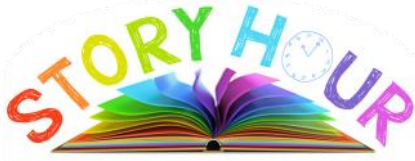

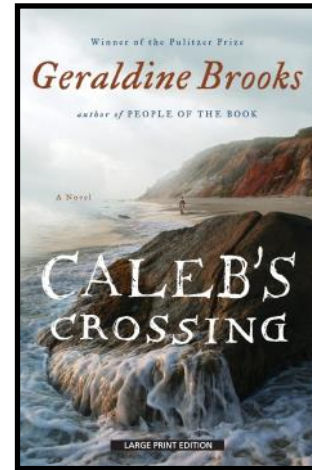
Access Ancestry® Library Edition for genealogy research here on our public computers. (Home access is not available at this time.)

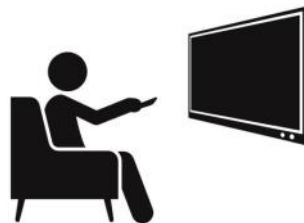
